Treasured for its beauty since ancient times, onyx features natural variations in color, pattern and stone structure. These unique organic variations mean each piece crafted from onyx is truly one of a kind.

Care Instructions

- Address spills immediately by wiping with a dry, soft cloth. Natural stone is a porous material, and although it has been sealed, spills should be blotted promptly to minimize staining.
- Dust regularly with a soft, damp cloth, followed by a dry one.
- Do not use window cleaning fluids, scouring compounds, gritty cloths, or strong solvents such as alcohol, ammonia or acetone as they may damage the finish.
- Use coasters, trivets and placemats for protection against hot or wet items.
- Surfaces are not scratch- or heat-resistant and may scuff or stain without proper care. To maintain stone's natural appearance, avoid using sharp objects on surfaces.
