



Painted Linen

Behind the Design

Painted linen brings a beautifully soft, textured look to case goods. To achieve this unique look, linen fabric is laminated onto engineered wood, painted, then topped with a protective coat of nitro cellulose salient.

Care Instructions

- To maintain quality and appearance, avoid placing sharp objects on surface, as material is not scratch-resistant.
- Use coasters, trivets and placemats for protection against hot or wet items.
- Address spills immediately by wiping with a soft, dry cloth.
- Spot-clean as needed with a soft cloth and mild soap.
- Dust regularly with a soft, damp cloth, followed by a dry one.
- Avoid using strong, abrasive or chemical-based cleaners plus solvents including paint thinner, acetone or furniture polish with bleach, which can damage surface.
- Avoid exposure to heat, which can damage surface.
- Keep away from direct sunlight to avoid fading or discoloration.
- Avoid placing near a heat source to prevent premature cracking.
