Widely considered Britain's greatest artist, John Constable is often called the father of Modern Impressionism. He aimed to "hold the glass up to nature" through his paintings of English landscapes. Popular acclaim only reached Constable after his death in 1837, due to his rejection of the era's dominant Classicism.
