His collages featured scraps of paper and packaging — the discards of society reflecting the decline in economic and political stability following WWI. 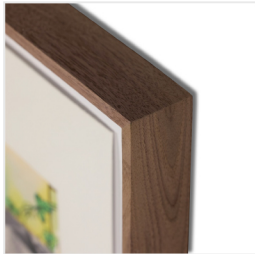
