## ASSEMBLING, USE AND CONSERVATION INSTRUCTIONS - USA & CANADA

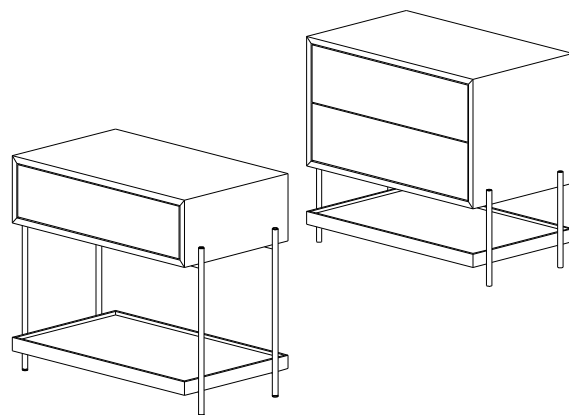
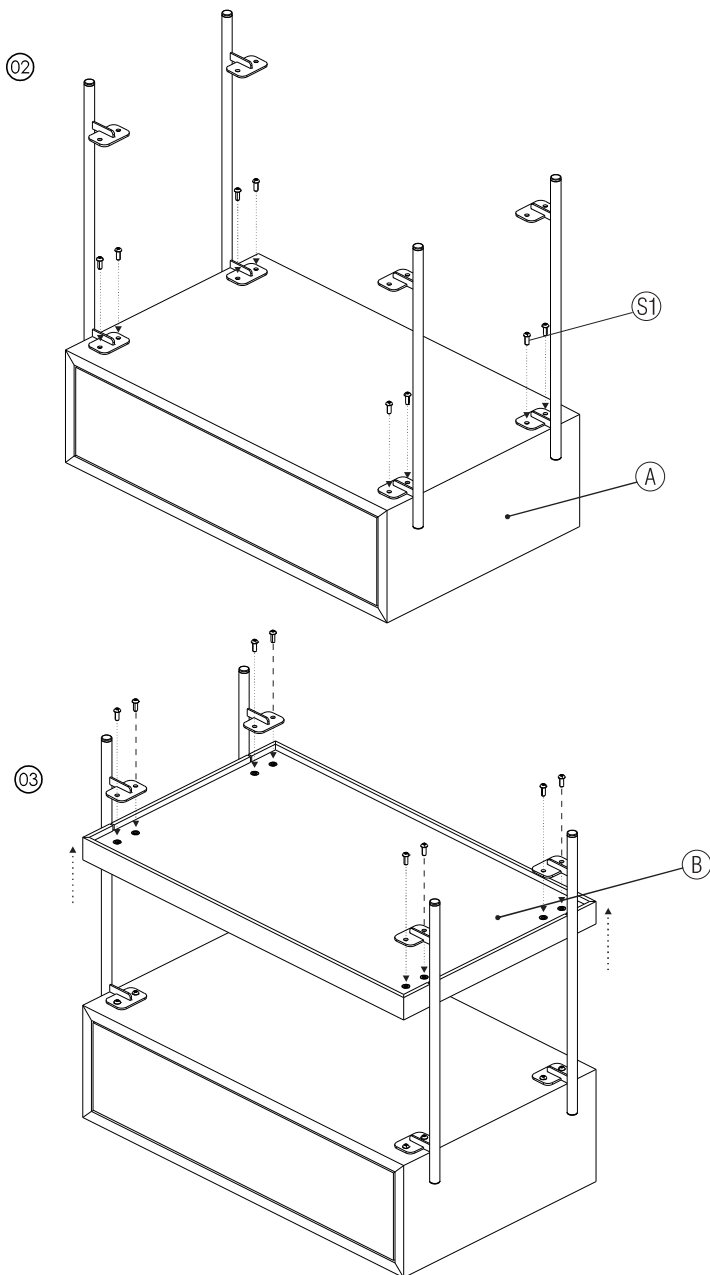
COLLECTION: Clean  
APPLICATION: Bedside Table  
DESCRIPTION: Accord Clean Bedside Table  
MATERIALS: Natural wood veneer, MDF, carbon steel.

Read carefully all the instructions for the removal of the package and for the correct assembling, use and application:

### ASSEMBLING THE TABLE

- ① Remove the protecting package taking care to not scratch or cut the product. Place the curved parts of the table in a flat and clean surface to avoid scratches in the natural wood during the assembling process.
- ② With the lower holes of the niche facing upwards, proceed the assembling of the metal rods in the niche holes. To perform this operation, use the provided screws (S1) and 4mm allen wrench to secure the proper fixation of the metal rods in the furniture.
- ③ Next, insert the base (B) between the metallic rods and the existing cutout in the base, fix it with the screws (S1), following the instructions as shown in the diagram.
- ④ After all the processes carried out, arrange the table in the desired location.

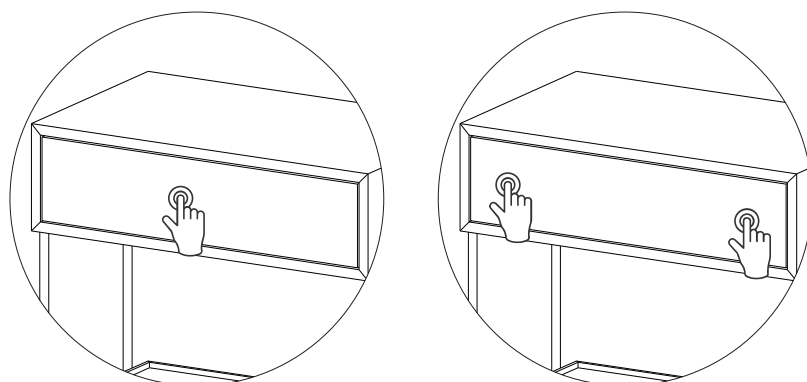

### OPENING AND CLOSING DRAWERS



Read carefully all the instructions for the removal of the package and for the correct assembling, use and application:

### USER GUIDE

To open the drawer, gently push the front part of the drawer.

To properly close your drawer, is recommended to always close it pressing the center of the drawer or with both hands, each one in one of the sides of the drawer, making sure the furniture's slide properly lock. (As shown in the diagram).

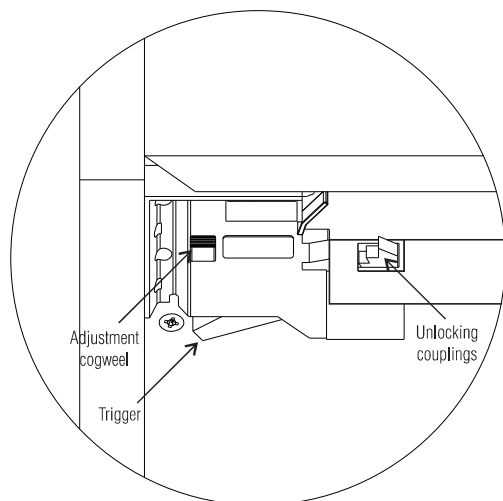
Avoid placing glasses, bottles and other containers that are too hot, cold or wet on the table, in order to avoid permanent stains on the natural wood veneer.

The table must be cleaned using only a cloth slightly moistened with water and neutral soap, avoiding any abrasive cleaning product.

### SLIDES REGULATION

In case of drawer desregulation, proceed as follows: Open the drawer and notice that, at the bottom, there is two plastic supports. You can find a cogwheel in each one of them, which you can roll to adjust the height. Turning them clockwise, the drawer will rise. Counter-clockwise, it will go down.

To remove the drawer out of the furniture, press both triggers located on the sides of the plastic support. With the triggers pressed, pull out the drawer, taking it out. To put back the drawer in the furniture, place it above the sliders and close it. It will make the plastic supports lock themselves to the sliders. Make sure that all couplings are properly locked.
