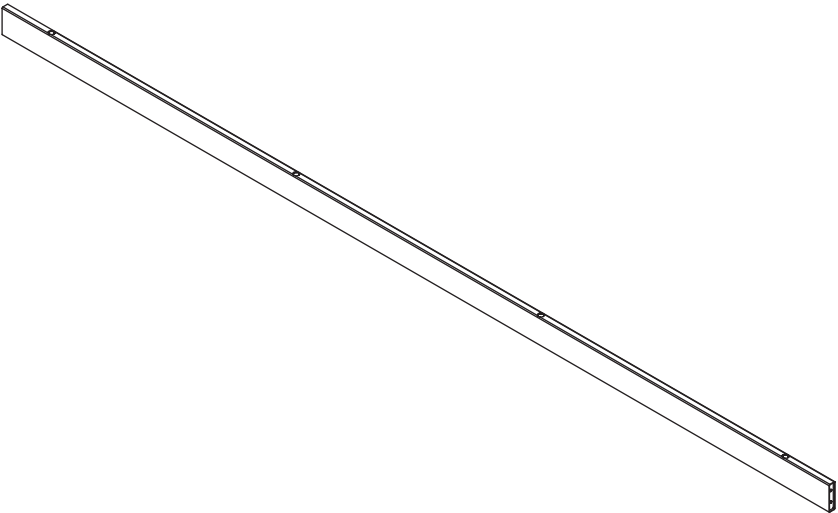
Your Elements cabinet includes an air-purifying pouch that contains chemical-free, non-toxic, activated carbon. This pouch is designed to absorb and remove trace odors which may remain as a result of the unique process used when crafting Elements' doors. While any remaining odor will naturally dissipate over time, the pouch accelerated this effect. Feel free to keep the pouch inside the cabinet indefinitely or transfer it to any area of the home where you want to manage moisture or odors. If you choose to use it elsewhere (shoe racks, closets, basements, etc.), be aware that the pouch can be "recharged" by placing it in direct sunlight for 1-2 hours after 2-3 months of usage.

HARDWARE AND COMPONENTS

Elements cabinets are available with two base options. Depending on the base that you have selected, your configuration will include one of these two sets of components.

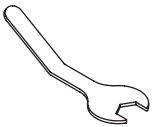

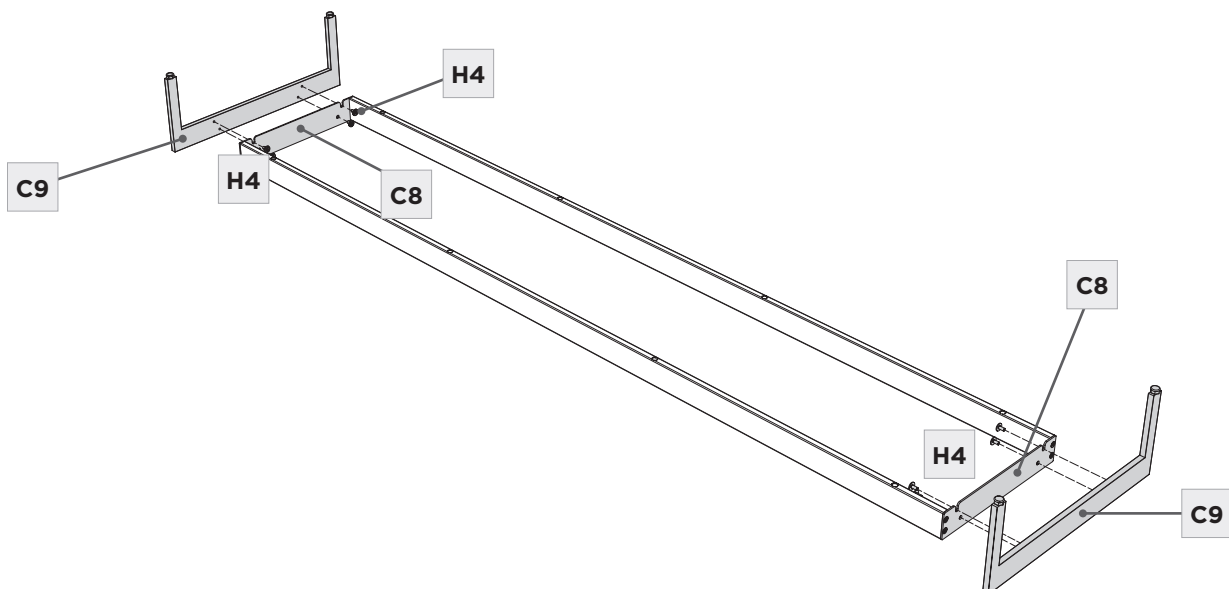
CONSOLE BASE

To assemble the Console Base, lay the **Spanners (C7)** on a soft, non-marring surface, like carpet. Attach the **Connection Plate (C8)** to the **Spanners (C7)** using **8 Screws (H5)** and tighten with **Hex Wrench (T2)**.

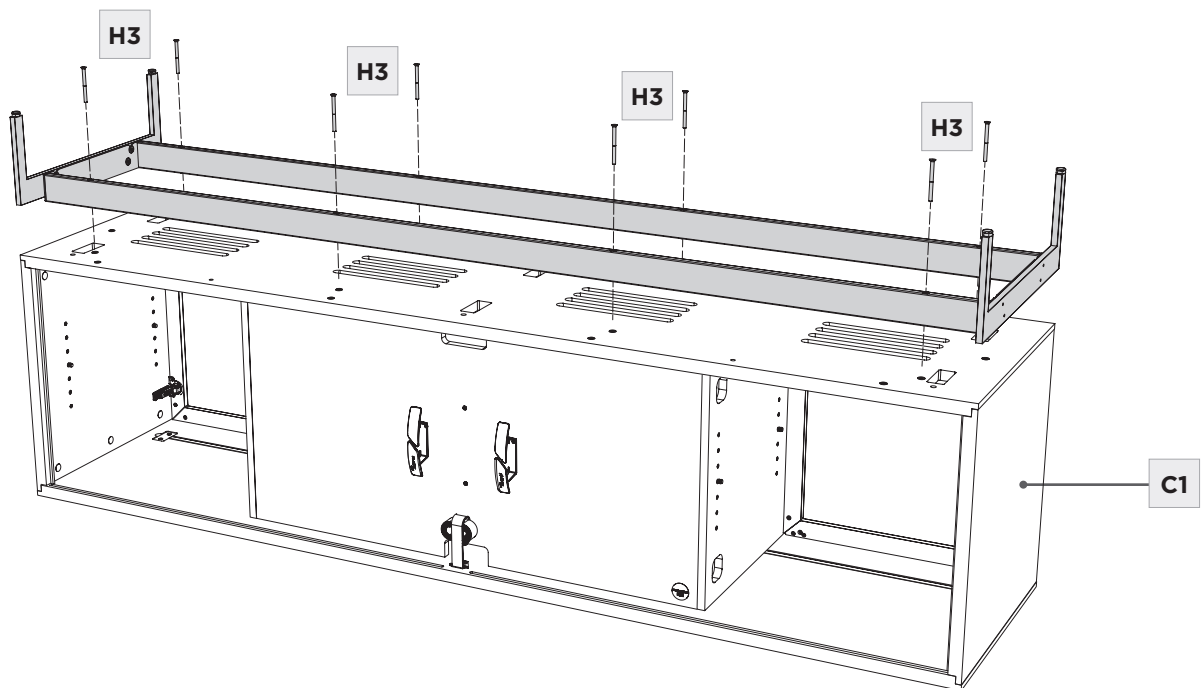
Attach the **Legs (C9)** to the **Connection Plate (C8)** using **8 Screws (H4)** and tighten with **Hex Wrench (T2)**.



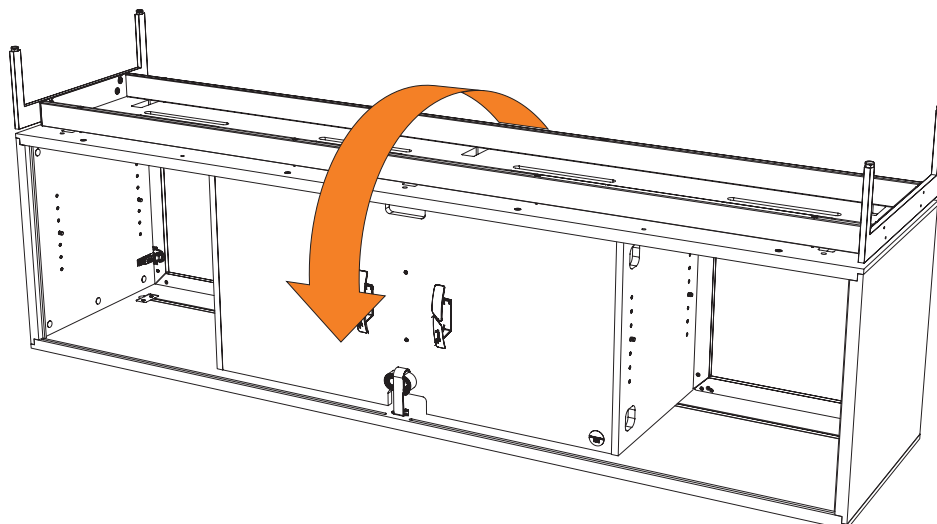
CONSOLE BASE

Lay the **Cabinet (C1)** on its top on a soft, non-marring surface, like carpet. Attach the Base to the **Cabinet (C1)** using **8 Screws (H3)** and tighten with **Hex Wrench (T2)**.




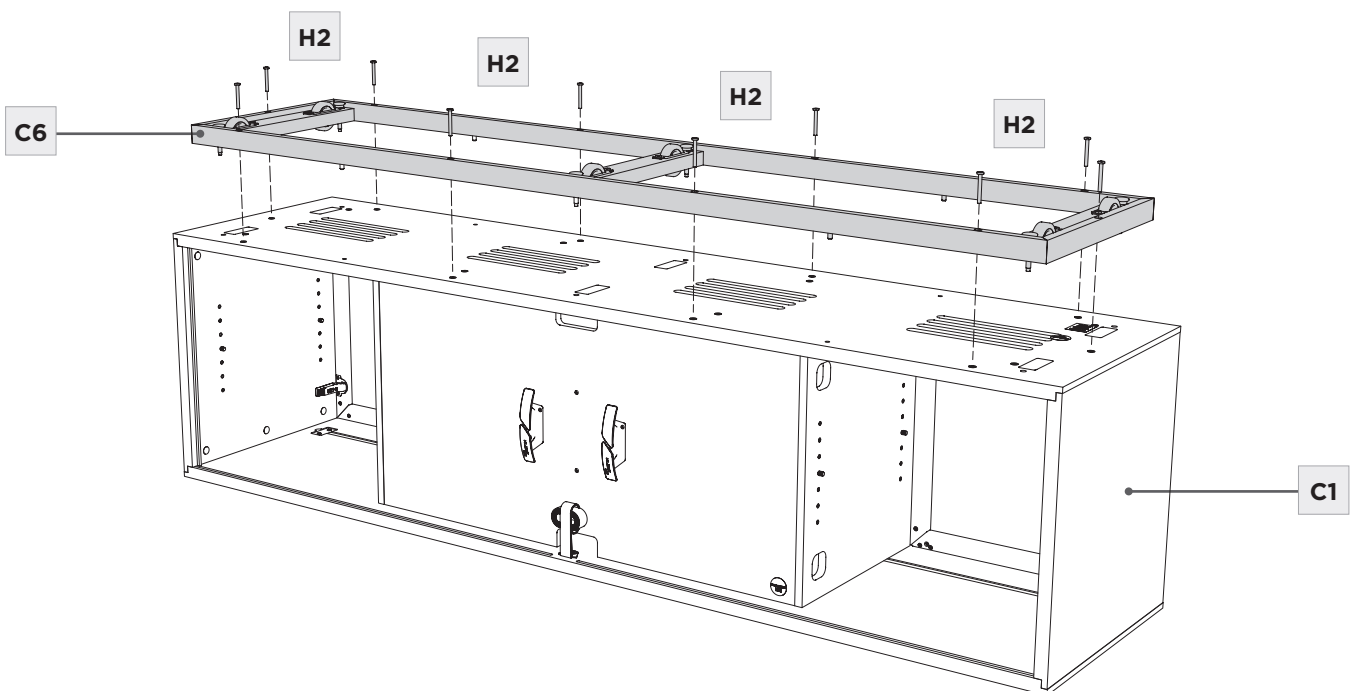

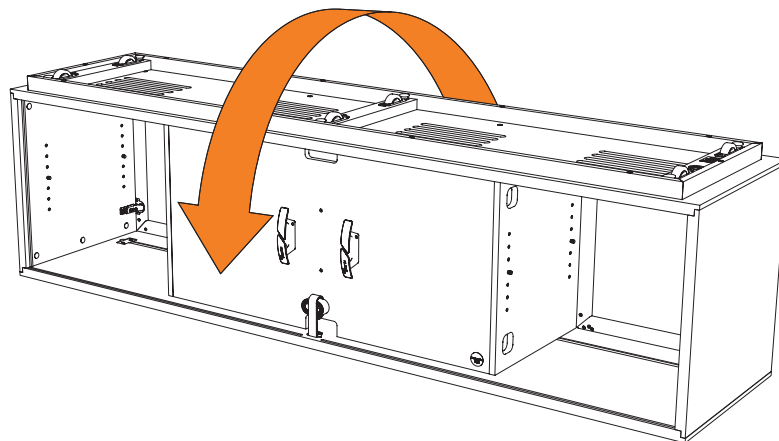
ROLLING PLINTH BASE

Lay the **Cabinet (C1)** on its top on a soft, non-marring surface, like carpet. Attach the **Rolling Plinth Base (C6)** to the **Cabinet (C1)** using **10 Screws (H2)** and tighten with **Hex Wrench (T2)**.

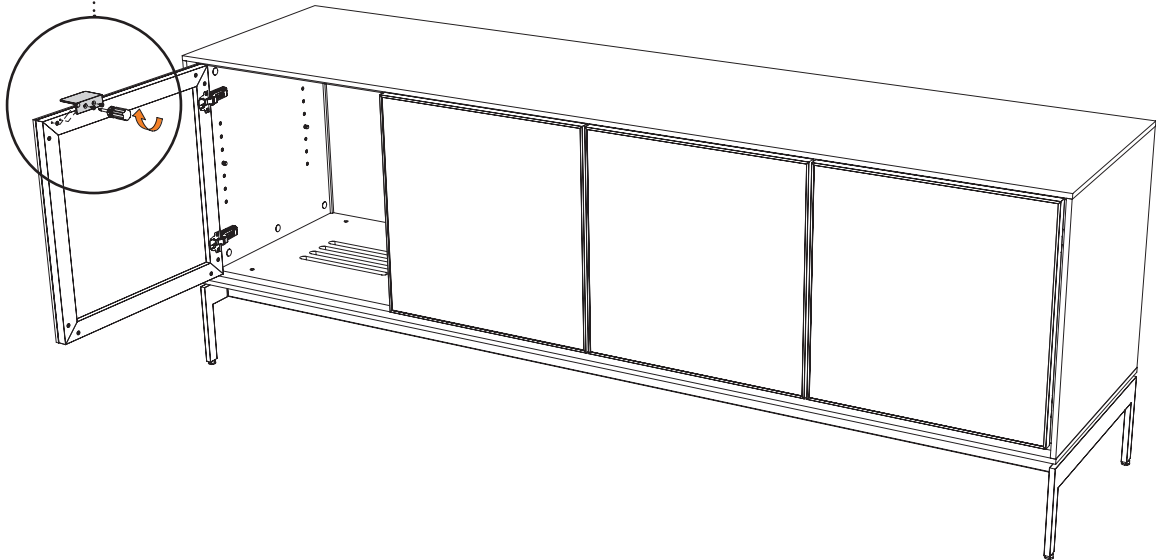
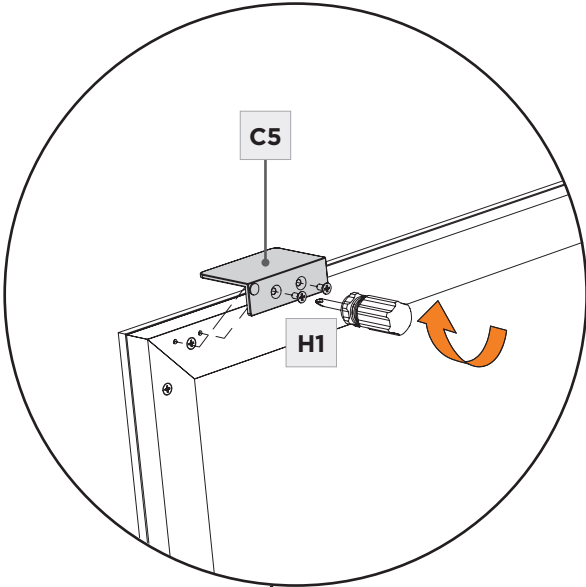


STEP 2. ATTACH DOOR PULLS

ASSEMBLY

Open the doors and connect the **4 Door Pulls (C5)** with **8 Screws (H1)**. Tighten with **Phillips-head Screwdriver (T1)**.



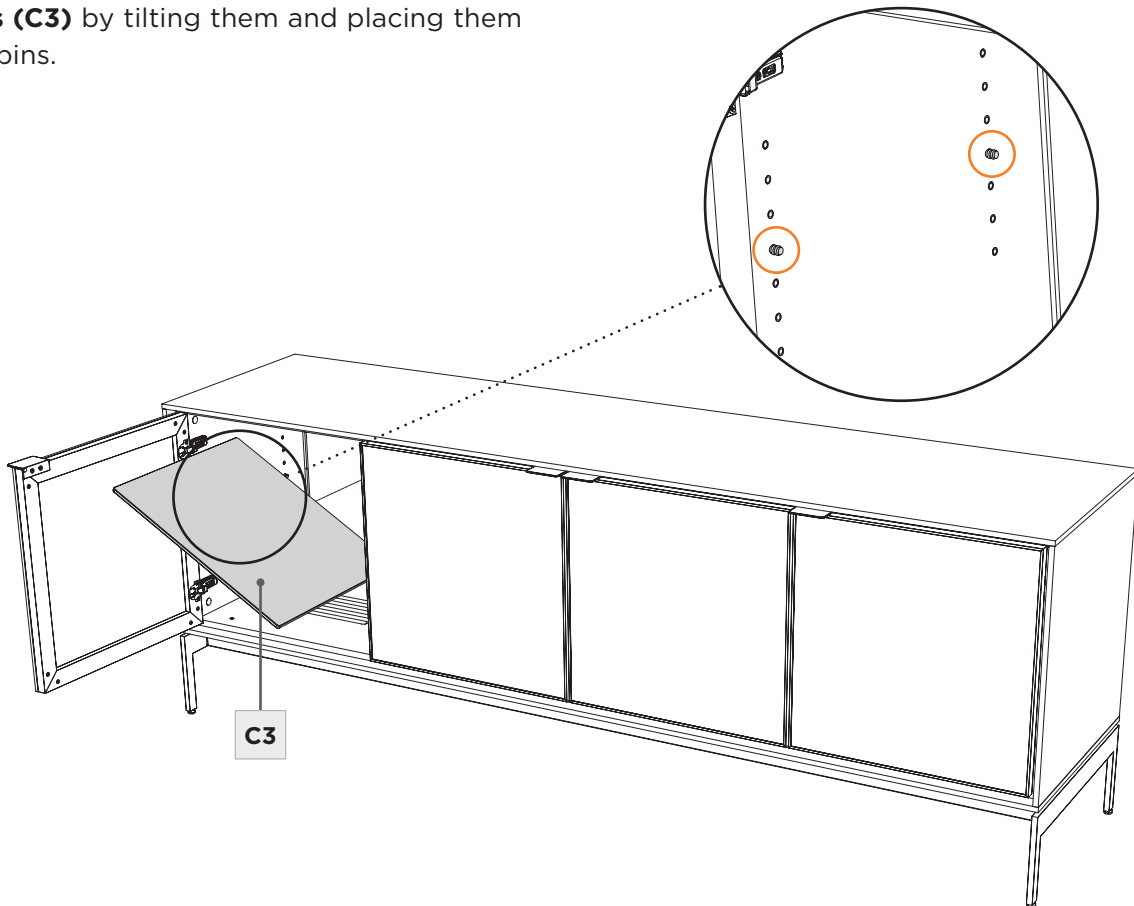

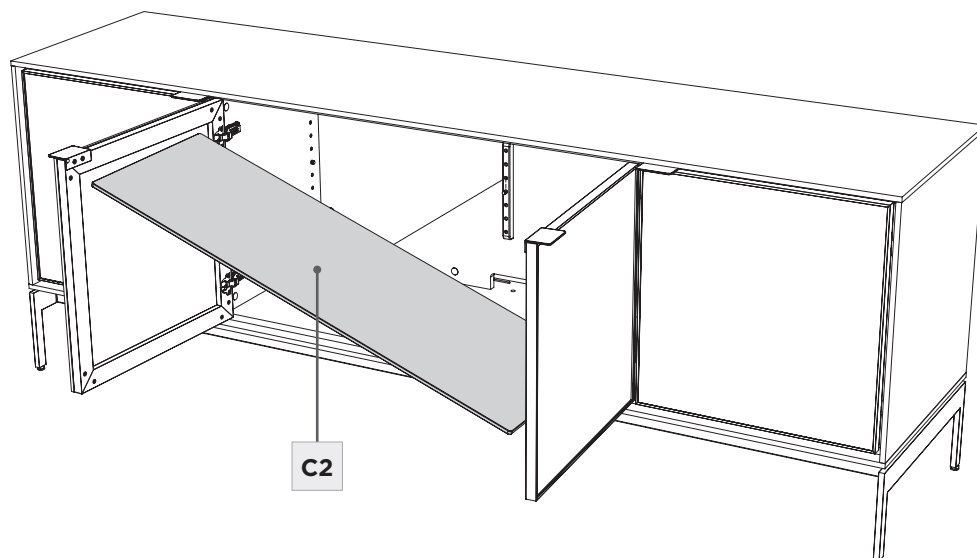
STEP 3. INSTALL SHELVES

Shelf pins are preinstalled in the center position and can be adjusted to any height desired. Loosen by hand or using the **Phillips-head Screwdriver (T1)**, if needed. Install the **Side Shelves (C3)** by tilting them and placing them on the pins.

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Repeat this process for the **Center Shelf (C2)**, adjusting the position of the Shelf Pins as needed. Note that there is a fifth Shelf Pin that supports the back center of the shelf. Install the shelf by tilting it and placing it securely on the pins.



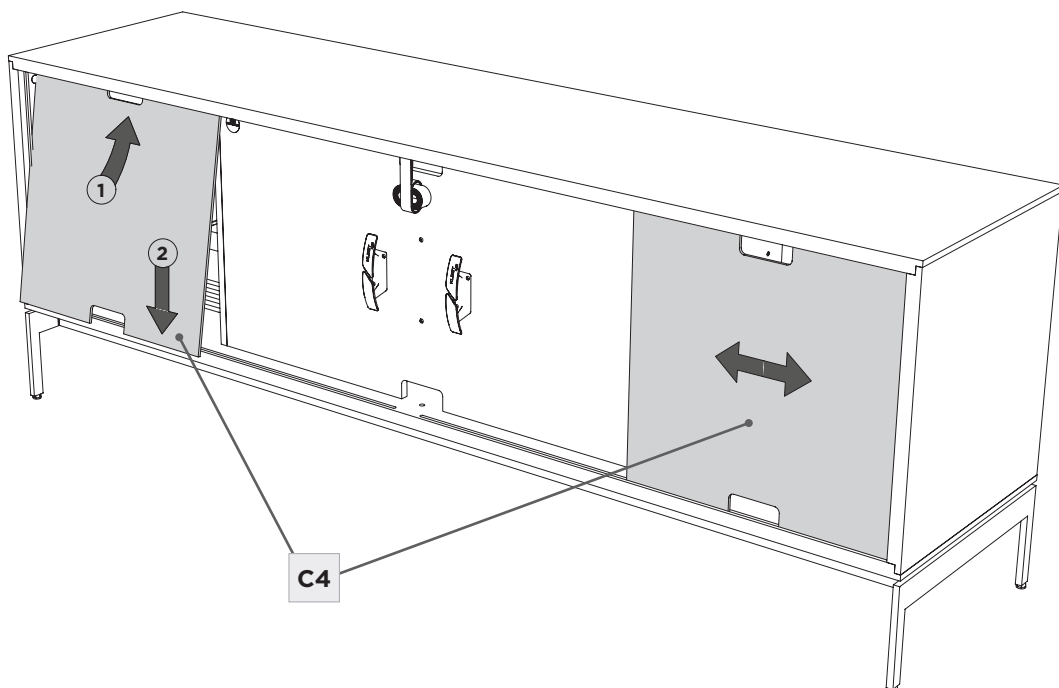
STEP 4. ATTACH BACK PANELS

ASSEMBLY

To install the cabinet's **Back Panels (C4)**, slide the top edge of one Back Panel into the groove in the underside of the cabinet's top panel.

Align the bottom edge of the panel over the groove in the cabinet's bottom and let the back panel drop into place. Repeat with the other panel.

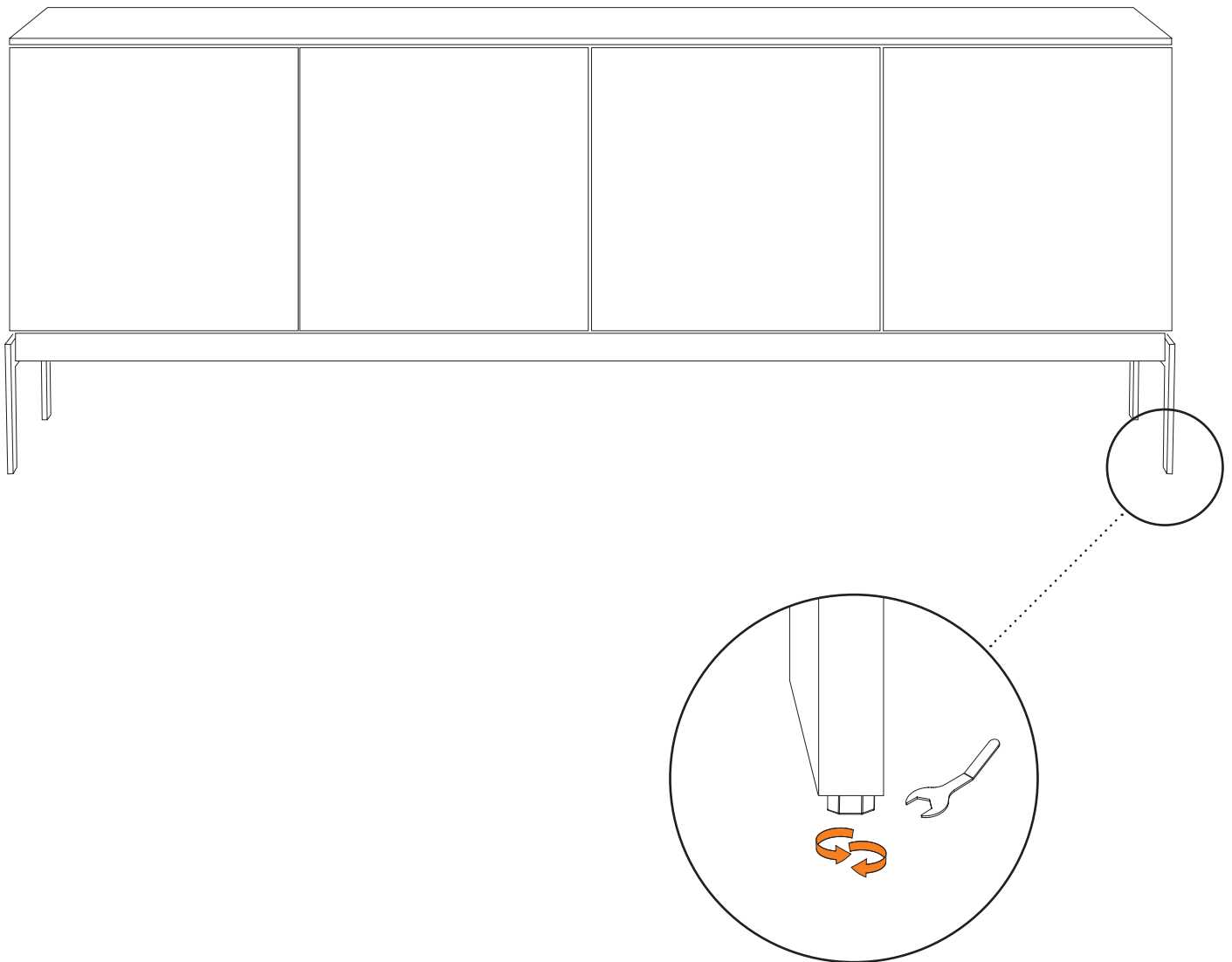
The panels can slide towards the center of the cabinet, allowing easy-access into the cabinet's side compartments.



CONSOLE BASE

Levelers are integrated into each leg assembly of Elements model 8709 and are accessed at the bottom of each cabinet leg. If your floor is uneven, you may extend one or more leveler to attain a level, stable cabinet placement.

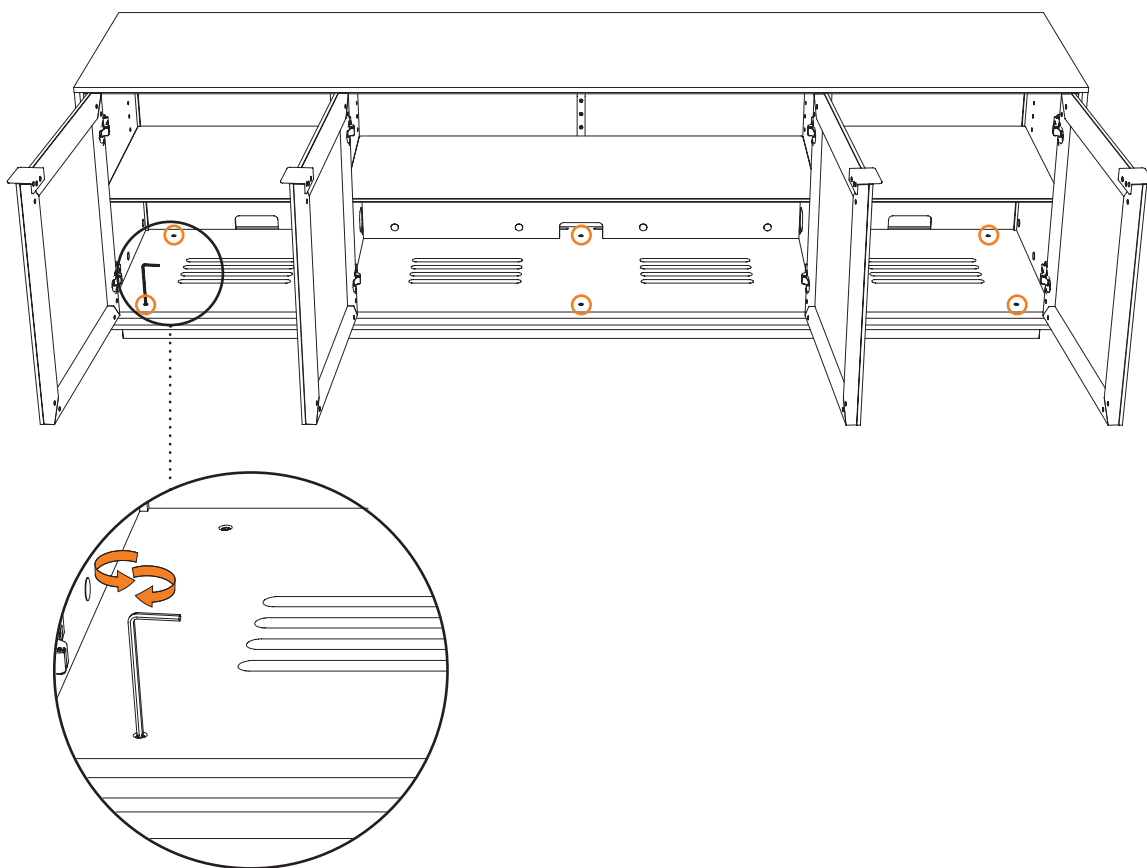
Place a level (not included) on top of the cabinet and use the **Leveler Wrench (T3)** to adjust the levelers located on the foot of each leg of the base. Turning clockwise will extend the leveler; turning it counter-clockwise will retract it.



ROLLING PLINTH BASE

Elements model 8703 is equipped with wheels to allow it to easily roll forwards and backwards for access to the rear of the cabinet. When you are finished wiring your components and no longer need access to the back of the cabinet, you have the option to raise your cabinet off its wheels to level it and secure it in place, if desired.


Place a level (not included) on top of the cabinet and use the **Hex Wrench (T2)** to adjust the levelers from within the cabinet. Start with the outer-most levelers until the cabinet is level, then adjust the center front and rear levelers.



This step is to be completed after you have unpacked and completed the assembly of your cabinet and leveled it (if needed) in its final position. Due to jostling in freight or perhaps an uneven floor, the doors on your cabinet may not appear to be in perfect alignment. Making a few minor adjustments can rectify this situation.

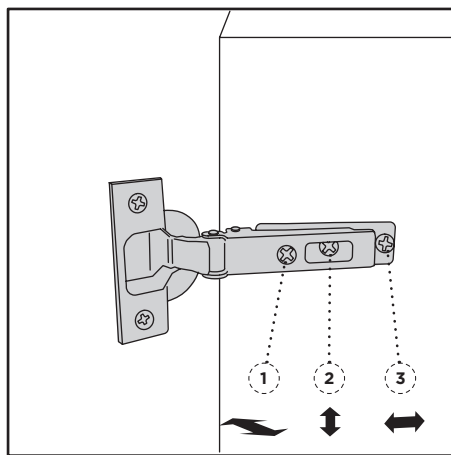
The doors on your cabinet should be evenly spaced and the doors should open and close freely without rubbing against the door frame. Your cabinet's hinges are fully adjustable, allowing you

to modify the door's position left/right, up/down and in/out. Adjusting one hinge can sometimes cause the need for adjustments to other elements. But with a few adjustments, you can modify the orientation of the cabinet doors to make sure that they hang perfectly within your cabinet.

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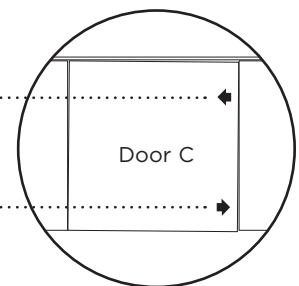
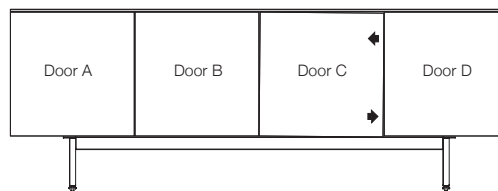
Use the **Phillips-head Screwdriver (T1)** to adjust the door hinges:

- By adjusting **Screw 1**, the door will move LEFT or RIGHT within the frame. Make minor adjustments at both top and bottom hinges for best results.
- By adjusting **Screw 2**, the door will move UP or DOWN.
- By adjusting **Screw 3** the entire door will move IN or OUT, opening or closing the gap between the door frame and cabinet. (This screw rarely needs adjustment.)



Tightening **Screw 1** on top hinge will open the seam between Door C & Door D here

Loosening **Screw 1** on this hinge will close the seam between Door C & Door D here



Your BDI furniture has been constructed with the finest materials, carefully manufactured, and designed to last a lifetime. Regular furniture care will prolong your enjoyment and keep it looking its best. Here are some general tips for taking care of BDI furniture. Your surfaces may vary.

GLASS

Glass surfaces are maintained using household glass cleaner and a paper towel or cloth.

SATIN-ETCHED GLASS

This uniquely smooth-to-the-touch glass surface can be regularly maintained using household glass cleaner and a paper towel or cloth.

A 'Magic Eraser' removes minor scratches or scuffs not eliminated using a paper towel or cloth. 'Magic Eraser' is a melamine foam product available at any grocery store or home improvement center. Dampen the entire glass surface and the Magic Eraser, then rub the whole surface in broad, even strokes using moderate pressure. Clean and dry the surface with a paper towel. Check for results and repeat as necessary. Any scratches or scuffing not eliminated by one of the above methods can often be addressed by 'refreshing' the glass. This process should not be required more than once per 6-12 months. See this brief video for the simple method: www.bdiusa.com/glass

WOOD

Wood surfaces should be cleaned with a slightly damp (not saturated) cloth or paper towel. Do not use glass cleaner on wood. If moisture remains, dry the surface with another cloth. If needed, a gentle, non-abrasive cleanser may be used, but wipe away all cleaner residue and dry the surface with a cloth.

BDI's wood finishes feature natural hardwood solids and veneers. Wood is a product of nature and—unlike man-made materials that can be manufactured to strict and consistent specifications—has natural imperfections that are part of its appeal and character. Every piece of wood differs from every other, even when coming from the very same tree. As such, grain, texture, and tone variation should be expected from one panel or piece of furniture to the next.

While BDI's stained wood finishes are stable in tone & appearance, all finishes are subject to some degree of discoloration with prolonged exposure to direct sunlight. Please avoid positioning your BDI cabinet in any area with ample direct sunlight. To learn more about the features of natural wood, visit www.bdiusa.com/wood

METAL, PORCELAIN, & PAINTED SURFACES

Surfaces should be cleaned with a slightly damp (not saturated) cloth or paper towel. If moisture remains, dry the surface with another cloth. If needed, a gentle, non-abrasive cleanser may be used, but be sure to wipe away all cleaner residue and dry the surface with a cloth.

WARRANTY

BDI warrants to the original purchaser that for the below-stated warranty term, BDI will replace any product, part, or component covered by this warranty that fails under normal use as a result of a defect in material or workmanship. The decision to replace a complete product versus the part or component in question will be at BDI's sole discretion.

Residential Use: BDI Furnishings carry warranty coverage for three (3) years from the date of product delivery, as shown on your sales receipt/documentation. Select chairs carry coverage for five (5) years from the date of product delivery.

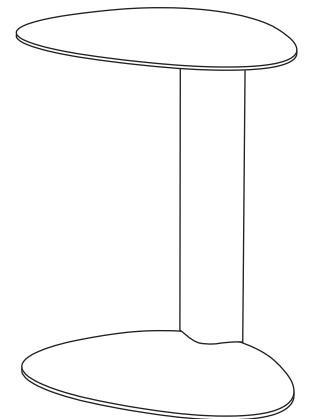
Commercial Use: BDI Furnishings carry warranty coverage for one (1) year from the date of product delivery, as shown on your sales receipt/documentation. Select chairs carry coverage for five (5) years from the date of the product delivery, based on an 8-hour daily use pattern.
