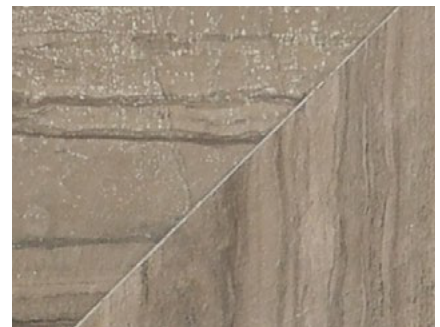


# TRAVERTINE

Serpeggiate Marble is a type of sandstone; formed by the accumulation of stone particles after washing by water and accumulating for thousands of years. It features a beautiful texture that is like wood grains and is an absolute visual delight.



- Wipe up spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth.
- Avoid cleaning with rough materials, harsh abrasives, polishes, or cleaners with bleach.
- Use coasters or felt pads on tables to preserve the marble's finish.
- Keep in a dry place to avoid absorbing moisture.
- Avoid placing in direct sunlight for long periods of time. Prolonged exposure to sunlight may turn the stone yellow.
- Keep away from fire to avoid cracks.
