Install the Fixture



- Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 For Models with Short Shade: Use shade screws and finial to secure short shade. Repeat for remaining short shades.
- 3 Screw the lamp(s) into the socket(s). Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 4 Place the long shades onto the socket and secure in place by screwing the collar nut onto the socket using the provided shade tool. Repeat for remaining shades.
- **5** Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 6 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- 8 Neatly tuck the wiring into the junction box, place the fixture base onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using fixture screws.
