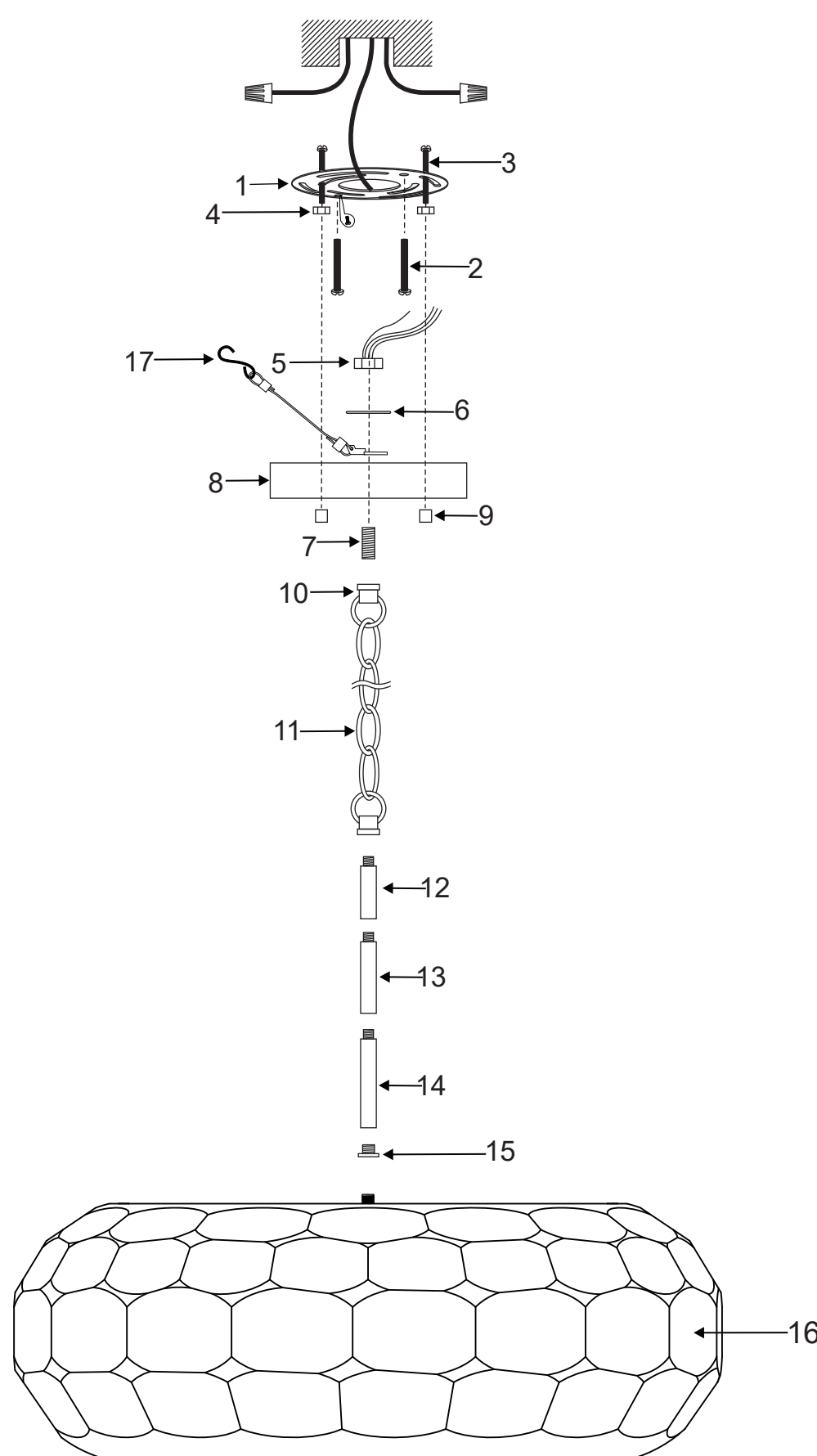


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS for the 360241 Fixture

Important Safety information (Please read before proceeding)

1. Remove the fixture, parts and all mounting hardware bags (orange) from the carton and verify that all parts are present according to the illustration sheet. All parts must be used as indicated. Do not replace any parts, leave any parts out, or use any parts which are worn out or broken. **Failure to follow the instructions could cause a hazardous situation, voids the warranty and violates the U.L. listing of the fixture.**
2. To prevent the electric shock, turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture. **NEVER attempt to install, clean or replace bulbs without shutting off the electricity to the fixture.**
3. **Never use light bulbs with wattage ratings that exceed the fixtures maximum rating.** Always make sure the electric current is turned off before changing the bulbs.
4. If you experience difficulties installing the lighting fixture or it fails to work as expected, please contact a local qualified licensed electrical contractor.
5. Please contact your local Capital Lighting Fixture reseller with any assembly or installation questions. Your local reseller can also provide you with replacement parts for your new fixture.
6. The weight of this fixture requires it to be installed with heavy duty mounting hardware and a safety wire that extends from the building structure to the fixture. The heavy duty mounting hardware and safety wire kit is included in the packaging and should be installed per these instructions.

Assembly Instructions to HANG the 360241 Fixture by the Chain

1. Pass Lead wire from fixture (16) through Reducer (15) unassembled Rod (14) Rod (13) and Rod (12), then screw all together. Note The fixture height can be adjusted by varying the number of Rods or chain used in the assembly.
2. Pass lead wire through chain Nipple (7) and canopy (8) then slip lock washer (6) thread Hex nut (5) on to Nipple (7). Finally, tighten hex nut (5).
3. Find appropriate threaded holes on Mounting bar (1), and assemble mounting screw (3) into threaded holes with Hex nuts (4).
4. Attach mounting bar (1) to outlet Box with Outlet Box mounting Screws (2).
5. Raise whole Fixture Canopy (8) toward outlet Box, then hang it onto Mounting Bracket (1) with Safety Cable w/Hook (17) as the illustration shown. Note: this will allow for Fixture to be supported while wire connection are made.
6. Connect fixture ground wire to the outlet box ground wire with wire connector supplied, connect the common wire of the lamp cord to the Power supply with the wire with wire connector supplied, connect supply wire of the lamp cord to the power supply black wire with wire connector supplied. *Note: this Fixture is wired using 2 conductor lamp cord. The insulation between the two conductor one of the lamp cord can be split down the center for better access to the two conductor. the common wire of the lamp cord is identified as the conductor with ribs embossed in the rubber wire insulation.*
7. Push Fixture to ceiling carefully passing mounting screws (3) through holes in canopy (8) then verify all wires are securely inside canopy (8). Finally, secure fixture to ceiling with cylinder nuts (9).

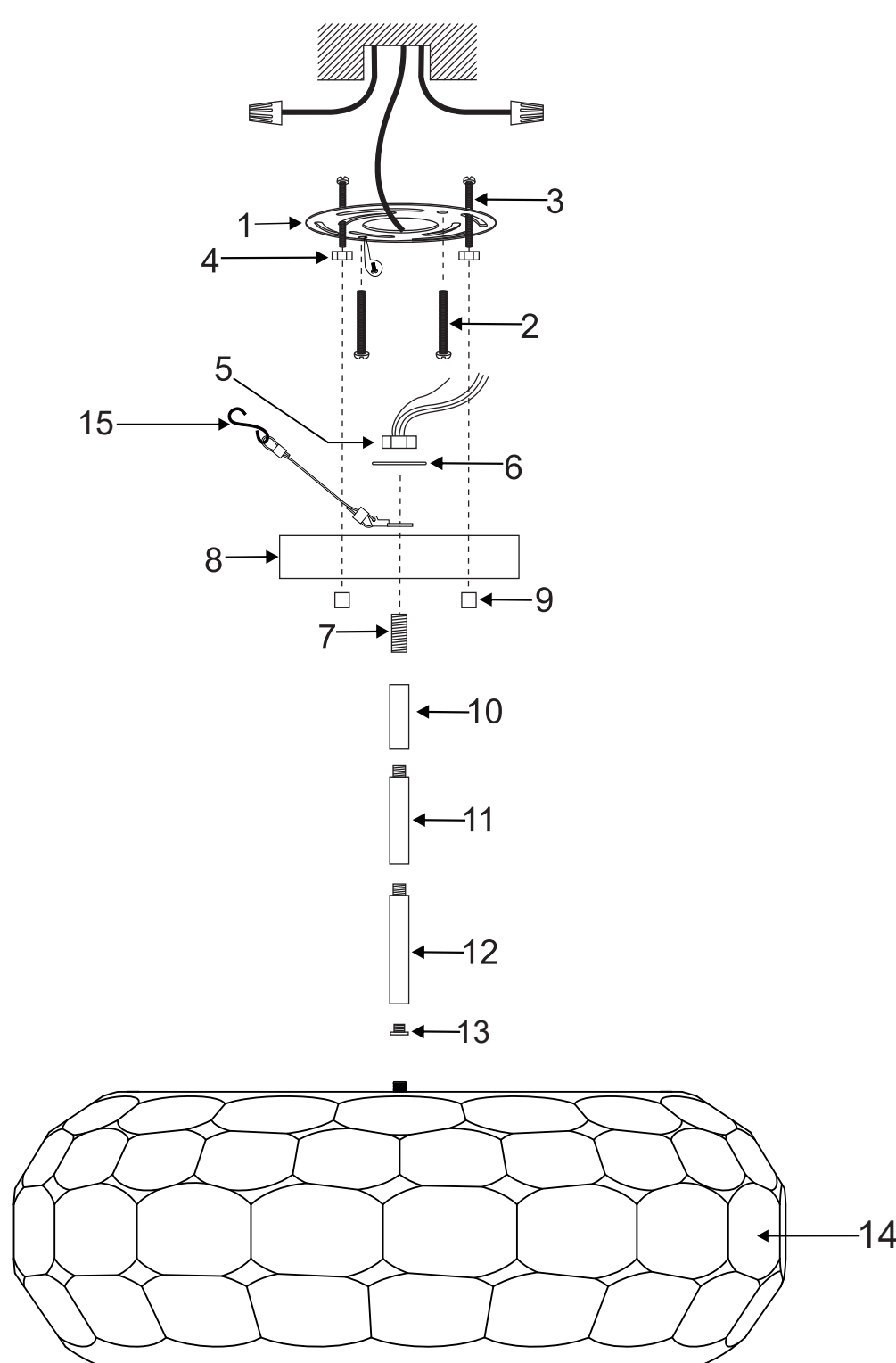

Assembly Instructions to ROD MOUNT the 360241 Fixture

1. Pass Lead wire from fixture (14) through Reducer (13) unassembled Rod (12) Rod (11) and Rod (10), then screw all together. Note The fixture height can be adjusted by varying the number of Rods or chain used in the assembly.
2. Pass lead wire through chain Nipple (7) and canopy (8) then slip lock washer (6) thread Hex nut (5) on to Nipple (7). Finally, tighten hex nut (5).
3. Find appropriate threaded holes on Mounting bar (1), and assemble mounting screw (3) into threaded holes with Hex nuts (4).
4. Attach mounting bar (1) to outlet Box with Outlet Box mounting Screws (2).
5. Raise whole Fixture Canopy (8) toward outlet Box, then hang it onto Mounting Bracket (1) with Safety Cable w/Hook (15) as the illustration shown. Note: this will allow for Fixture to be supported while wire connection are made.
