

# Care Instructions

# Coalbrook Table Matthew Hilton

To prolong the life of the product and retain its appearance and functionality, we would like to give you some relevant information and care advice:

This unit is manufactured with either Oak, Walnut stained Oak or Marble top with a powdercoated cast iron base. Craftsmen manufacture this product and there is variety between each unit because of the natural qualities of timber and stone.

**Wood care:**

- Natural timber and Marble is affected by sunlight; this can cause the colour to change and fade. For this reason, it is not recommended that placing objects in the same position for long periods of time is avoided. This potential colour adjustment becomes less relevant as the product ages.
- It is advised not to place the table into direct sunlight also for the same reasons as above.

**Wood + metal cleaning:**

- Gently clean the table with a soft microfiber cloth and a diluted mild detergent solution.
- Immediately dry the surface with a soft, dry cloth to prevent water spots and streaks.
- Avoid using abrasives, harsh chemicals and aerosol-powered cleaners on finishes and veneers.
- Avoid using polishes as this may affect and damage the lacquered finish.

**Marble care:**

- Wipe up spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth.
- Avoid alkaline or acidic liquids, as they can break down the protective sealant on marble surfaces.
- Apply protective pads to the undersides of items

being displayed on the stone surfaces to avoid leaving marks or scratches and it is advised to use coasters to avoid any water marks or stains appearing on the surface.

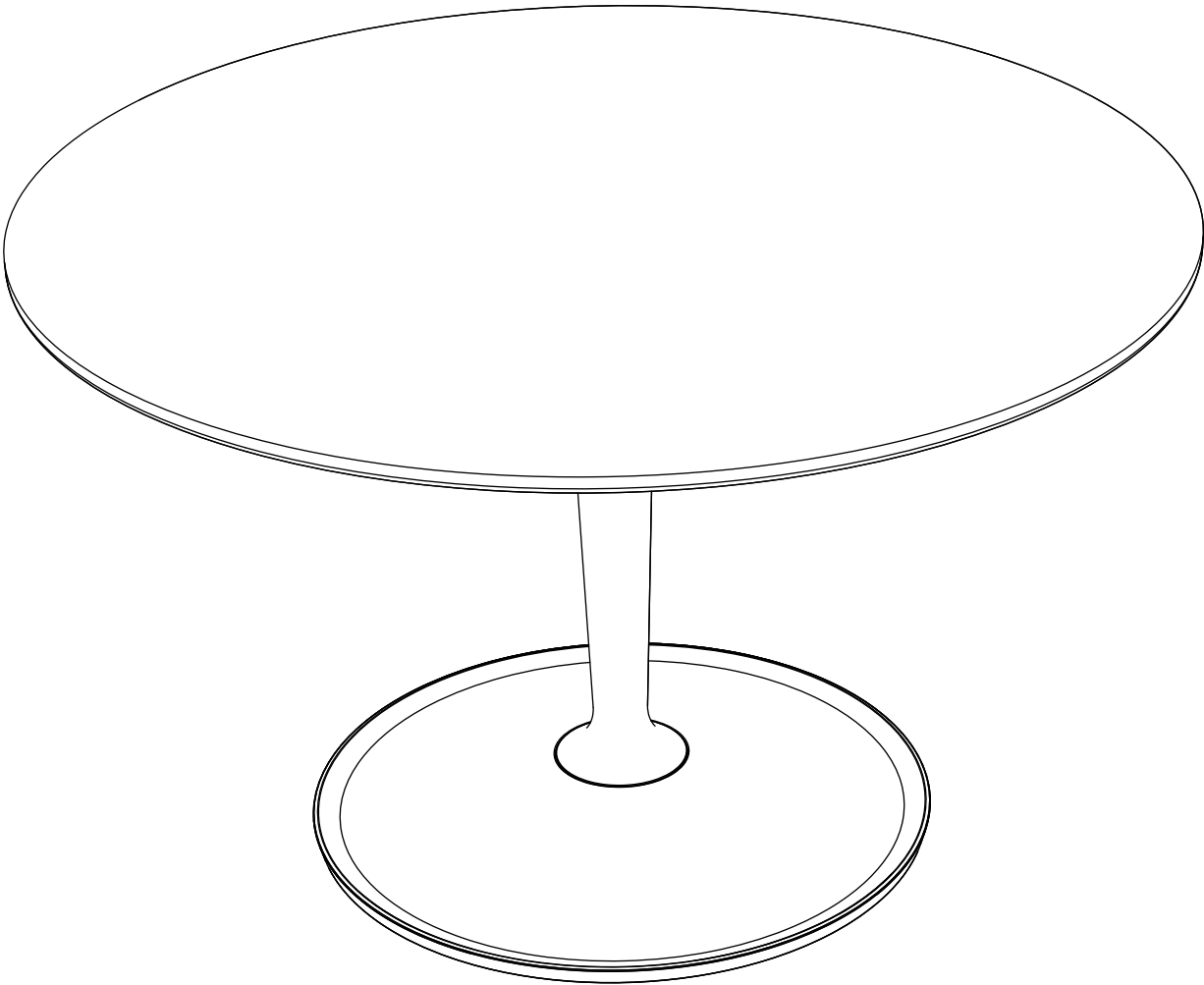
- Avoid putting extremely hot dishes directly on the surface.
- Avoid placing the table where there are extremes of heat as marble will contract and expand. Also if placed in direct sunlight the marble may fade with time.

**Marble cleaning:**

- Use a soft, dry microfiber cloth to dust marble surfaces regularly.
- For routine cleaning, use a mixture of warm water and a couple of drops of a mild dish soap. Dampen the cloth or sponge with the solution and wring it out well before wiping the marble.
- After cleaning with soap, rinse the surface with a cloth dampened in clean water to remove any soap residue.
- Immediately dry the surface with a soft, dry cloth to prevent water spots and streaks.
- Never use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they can scratch the marble's surface.
- Avoid ammonia, bleach and highly alkaline or acidic cleaners.

Assembly Instructions

- 1

Place the base into position where you would like to the table located. Screw threaded rod (A) into the base and fully tighten using the supplied Spanner (B).
- 2









Slide the pole over threaded rod and locate into place. Whilst still holding the pole or with assistance, place the metal plate on top. Take Washer (C), Nut (D) and Spanner (B) and loosely secure to the threaded rod untill thumb tight.
- 3

Rotate the metal top plate, until the holes in the pole align. Use 4 x bolt (E) and Allen Key (F) and fully tighten.
- 4

Fully tighten Nut (D) with Spanner (B).
- 5

With assistance place the top into position on the metal top plate and align the holes. Take 5 x bolt (G) and Allen Key (H) and fully tighten.

IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT 3-4 PEOPLE ARE USED TO PLACE THE TABLE TOP ONTO ITS CORRECT ORIENTATION.
