



Install the Fixture



- I Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- 2 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 3 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 4 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Neatly tuck the wiring into the junction box, place the fixture base onto the mounting plate, and secure it in place using fixture screws.
- 6 Screw the lamp into the socket. Refer to the label on the socket for max wattage information.
- Install the shade to the frame and secure it in place using the cap screw.
- Optional: Adjust the shade by turning it left or right until desired position is achieved. Do not turn the shade past the point indicated by red dotted line.
