Important Safety Instructions

WARNING: To avoid fire, shock and serious personal injury, follow

1. Read your owner's manual and safety information before installing your new fan. Review the accessories and instructions for each.
2. Before servicing or cleaning unit, switch power off at service panel and lock service panel disconnecting means cannot be locked, such as a tag, to the service panel.
3. Be careful of the fan and blades when cleaning, painting, or working near the fan. Always turn off power before servicing.
4. Do not insert anything into the fan blades while the fan is operating.
5. Do not operate reversing switch until fan blades have come to a complete stop.
6. The appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervision. You must ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Additional Safety Instructions

1. To avoid possible shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the fuse box before wiring, and do not touch wiring or electrical components.
2. All wiring and installation procedures must satisfy National Electrical Codes (ANSI/ NFPA 70) and must be grounded as a precaution against possible electrical shock. Electrical installation should be done by a qualified electrician.
3. The fan base must be securely mounted and capable of reliably supporting at least 35 lbs. See product support requirements. Consult a qualified electrician if in doubt.
4. The fan must be mounted with the fan blades at least 7 feet from the floor to prevent accidental contact.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your ceiling fan. If you do not have the knowledge or experience, have your fan installed by licensed electrician.
6. Suitable for use with solid-state speed controls.
7. This fan is to be used in dry locations.
