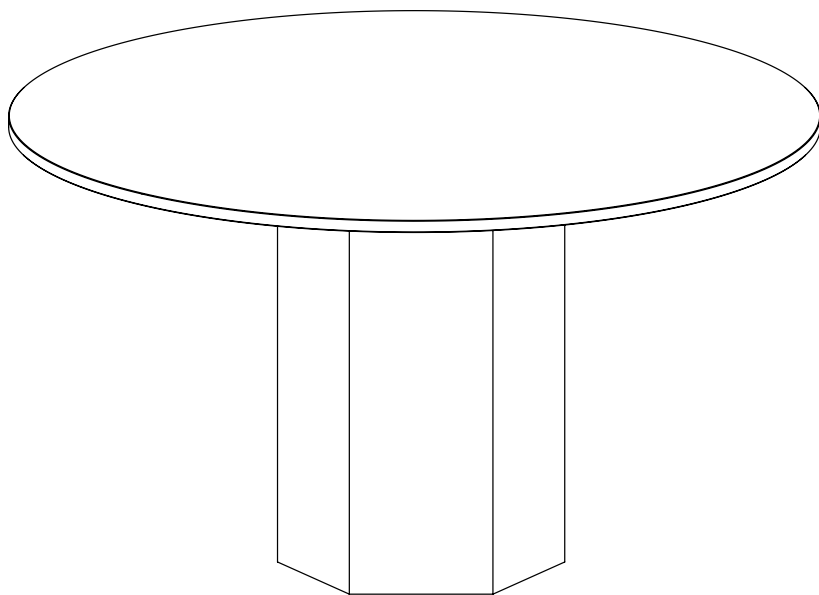

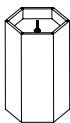

x1 Tabletop



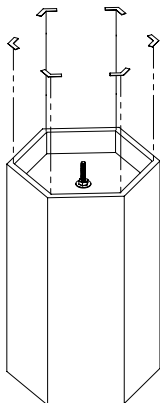
x1 Column



x12 Bumpers

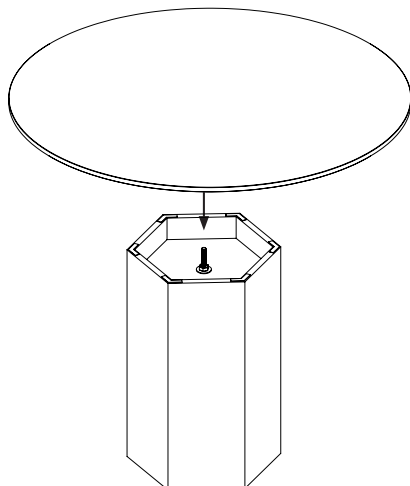
1.

Place the column with the bolt facing up.
Glue the bumpers on the corners of the column.



2.

Lift the tabletop onto the column. (Due to the weight of the tabletop it would be ideal if two people handle the lifting and a third person guides the tabletop in place).

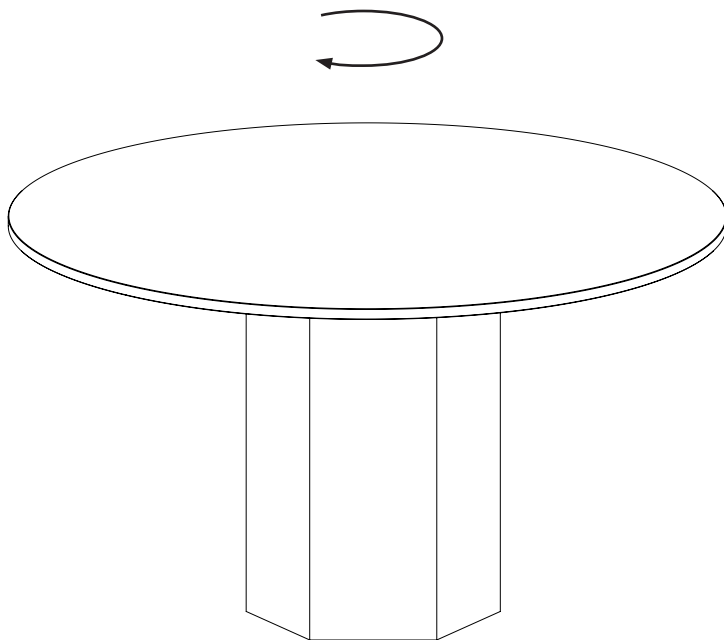

Screw the tabletop onto the bolt in the middle. Do not overtighten the top. Once it reaches the bumpers it does not need to be tightened more.

CAUTION:

DO NOT lift the table only by the tabletop. When moving the table, dismount the screws in the tabletop. Remove the tabletop from the column.





CARE INSTRUCTIONS

NATURAL STONE

All GUBI's stone tabletops get a protective treatment before they are sent to the customer. Stone is a natural product and as such it has variations in tone, colour, granularity and pattern. Because of this, a sample may not exactly match a slab or finished product. The samples should give a general idea of the colour, finish and pattern of the stone you choose.

All stones have veining and crystallizations that can appear to be pits but are actually a natural property of the stone. Stone forms over thousands if not millions of years. These slow processes lead to many variations in structure, colour and pattern. It is precisely these variations that make stone such an appealing material.

MAINTENANCE

Daily cleaning is carried out by wiping the surface with a damp soft cloth and then wiping dry. Stone is a absorbant material that can change its character if it comes into contact with acidic liquids such as vinegar, lemon juice or wine.

If you spill something acidic on the marble top, wipe it up with a damp cloth. Do not use scouring pads, acidic detergents or abrasive cleaners as they may damage the surface.

All our table tops are supplied with a sealant applied. Stone tops will require some maintenance every 8-12 months depending on use. This maintenance can be carried out using a commercially available product, following the instructions provided with the product.

During the winter period, a protective cover can be placed over the table top to ensure that water is drained away from the top.



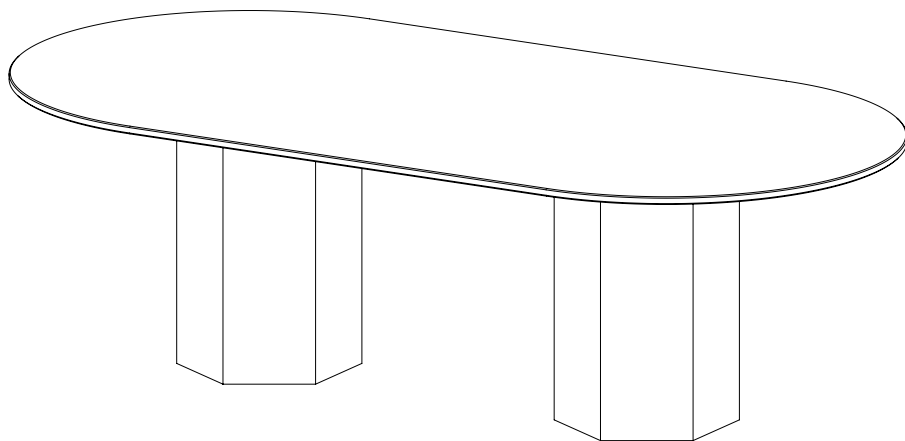

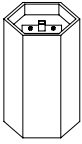

EPIC DINING TABLE – ELLIPTICAL



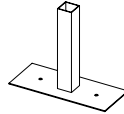

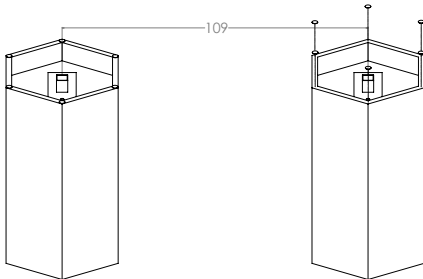

1.

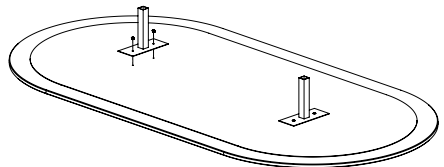
Place the columns upright on the floor, with 109 cm between the centers of the female mounting brackets.

Glue the bumpers on the corners of each column.



2.

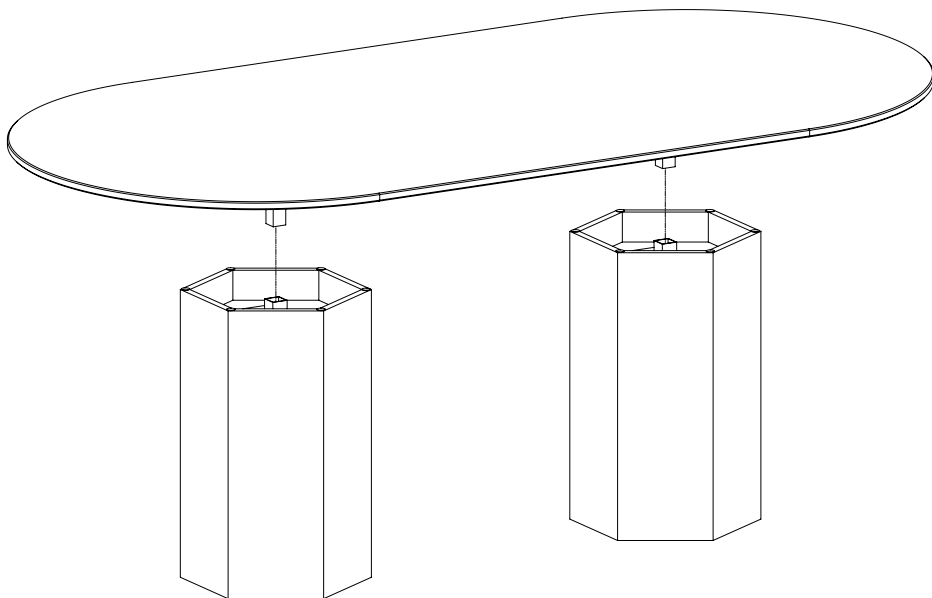
Attach the male mounting brackets on the underside of the tabletop, using the 4 screws.



3.

Lift the tabletop above the columns and align the male and female brackets. Carefully lower the tabletop down onto the columns.

(Due to the weight of the tabletop, we advise to have at least 4 people handle the lifting of the tabletop and 1 person guiding the tabletop into place.)





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
