

How to Install a Ceiling Fan

While installing or replacing a ceiling fan might seem complicated, ceiling fan installation is a relatively straightforward process. With a few basic tools and materials, you can learn how to hang a ceiling fan in just a few steps. Refer to your owner's manual for detailed installation instructions.

GETTING STARTED

30 inch
The fan blades should hang at least 30 inches from the nearest wall or obstruction.

7 feet
The fan blades should hang at least 7 feet from the nearest wall or obstruction.

Turn off Power
Check off power at the circuit breaker and turn off power before starting and turn it off and the wiring is complete.

1
Uninstall and Remove an Existing Fixture

SWITCH OFF
Turn off power at the wall switch.

VERIFY
Use a non-contact voltage tester to verify the power is off.

REMOVE
Remove the existing fixture and wiring.

After uninstalling the existing fixture, verify that the electrical box is ceiling fan rated. The ceiling fan box should be able to support 75 pounds.

Wire the Ceiling Fan

There are three main wiring methods for ceiling fans: standard pull-chain, pre-installed receiver, and remote receiver. Refer to your owner's manual for detailed wiring instructions.
