To architect and sculptor Jonathan Muecke, material is elemental, repetition is clarity, and logic is freedom. In his first commercial collaboration with Knoll, Muecke applies the principles of his art practice to create an all-wood dining collection with the familiarity of a kitchen table and chairs. "I like to take things for what they are and not try to imagine what someone intended them to be," explains Muecke. "Ultimately these are generous objects."

Benefits

- By using cylindrical solid wood dowels, Muecke erases the distinction between face and edge grain, and puts end grain on view for a beautiful expression of natural materiality
- Rounded wood pieces pass each other on nearby planes connected where they meet by a floating tenon, resulting in distinct joinery that's repeated across the collection
- The Muecke Wood Collection, which also includes a Side Chair and Armchair, is a cohesive collection for dining and collaborative settings in the workplace

- 1. **Cylindrical Dowels**
Unlike tables where the end grain is hidden, the Muecke Dining Table features cylindrical dowels that put the end grain on view
- 2. **Material Expressions**
Offered in a choice of solid oak, walnut, or ebonized ash, the table complements a variety of aesthetics
- 3. **Distinct Joinery**
To keep end grain exposed, the rounded wood pieces pass each other on nearby planes connected where they meet by a floating tenon
- 4. **Two Sizes**
Offered in two lengths to fit any dining room or collaborative setting
