**WARNING - ACRYLIC PRODUCT  
IMPORTANT NOTICE**

Take extra care when handling or moving the acrylic shade of the luminaire. Avoid touching it with any tools and keep away from any hard or abrasive surfaces (like rings, jewellery, watches, etc.). The edges and corners are especially fragile.

Keep the acrylic clean and wear gloves at all times. Do not put hands inside the acrylic body unnecessarily. This will allow for less cleaning and less chance to damage the acrylic.

Read and follow all steps carefully allowing the appropriate time for each step. Rushing the installation may cause accidents or damage.

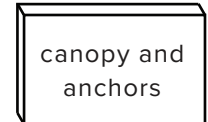
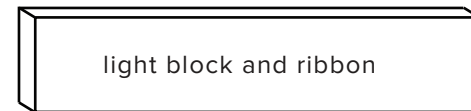


## PLEASE NOTE

the installation process requires it.



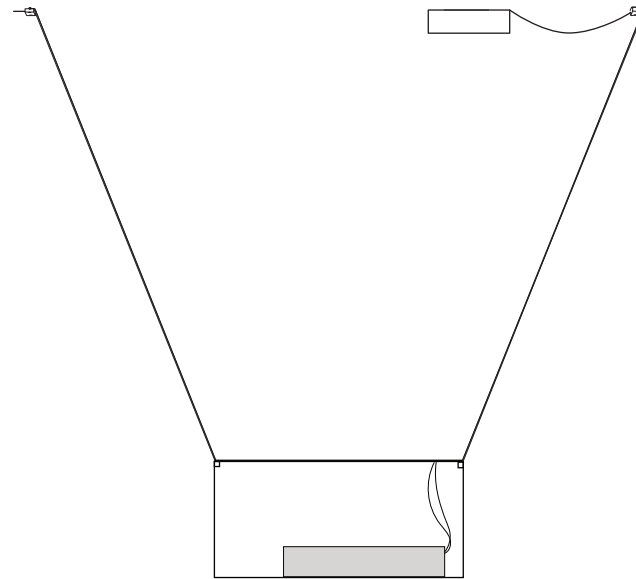

# INSTALL CEILING ANCHORS

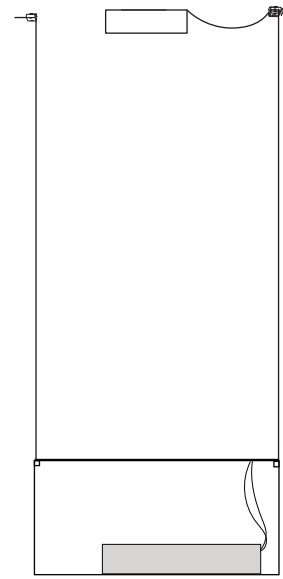

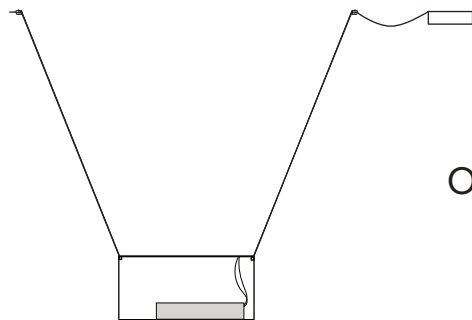

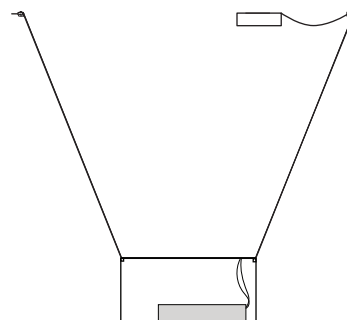
Chose the placement of your canopy, either exterior or interior

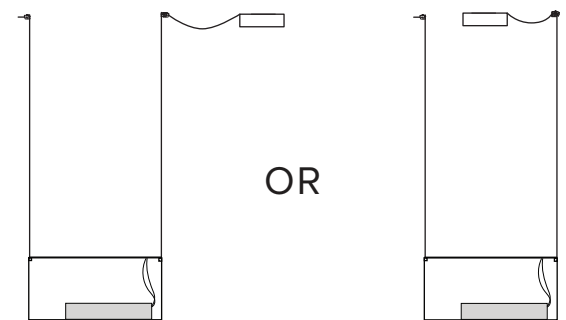

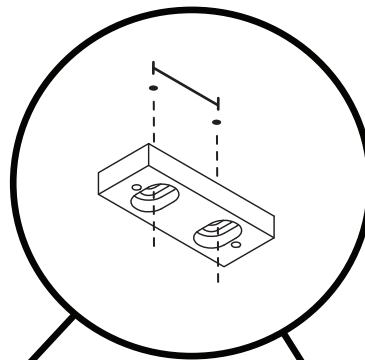

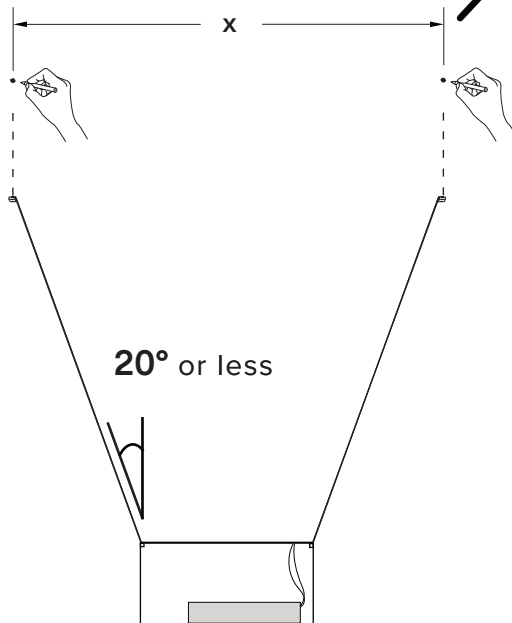
Mark your **X** dimension.

The distance is from center to center of each anchor.



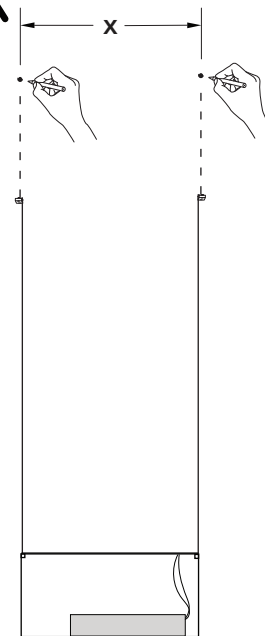
Use your anchor plate as a guide to make your marks.

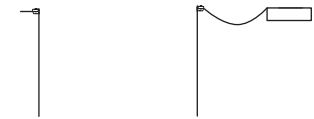


Choose your distance **X** for angled as long as it is less than 20°.

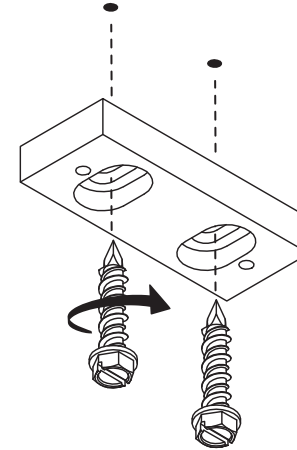


Make sure screw heads are fully immersed into the holes.



Assembly with N0.8 screws (or other) and washers (included)

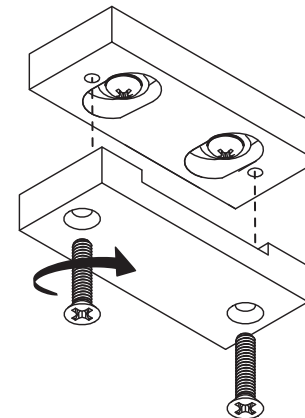

Partially screw the top plate of the anchor to temporarily allow the ribbon to freely pass through.

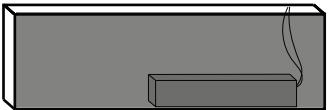

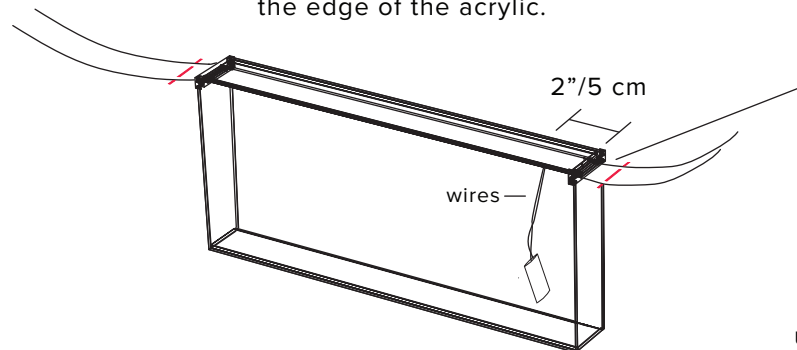
Place acrylic body on a flat, non abrasive surface. Undo twist ties and un-roll the ribbons.



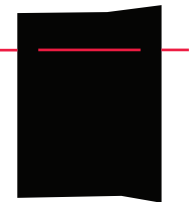
Pass both ribbons through the acrylic anchor system. Make sure there are no twists in the ribbon.



Pull ribbon until the acrylic shade is centered in between the two positioning threads. The wires should be approximately 2"/5cm from the edge of the acrylic.

Do not remove positioning thread until the installation is complete.

## INSTALL THE LUMINAIRE

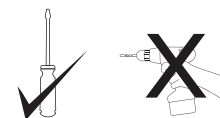
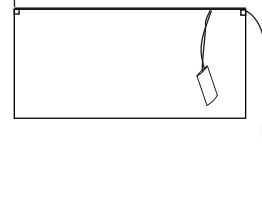
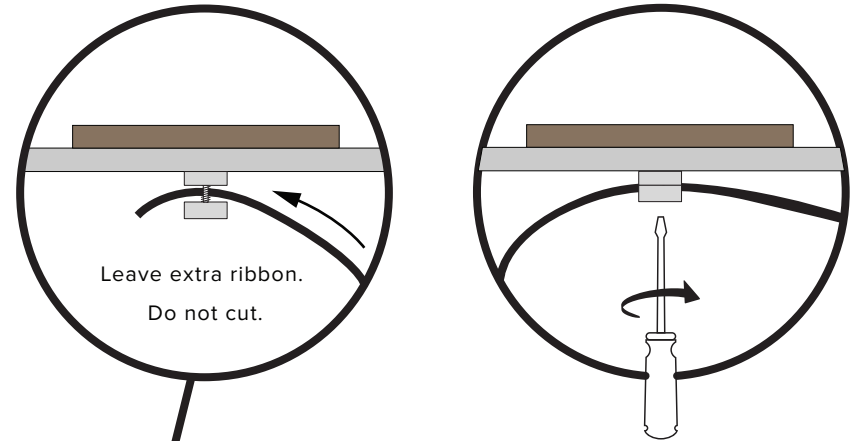
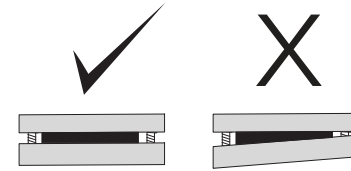

Pass the ribbon through each ceiling anchor. Make sure to leave enough ribbon for connection on the electrical side. Tighten ceiling anchors when desired length is achieved.

Make sure there are no twists in the ribbon.

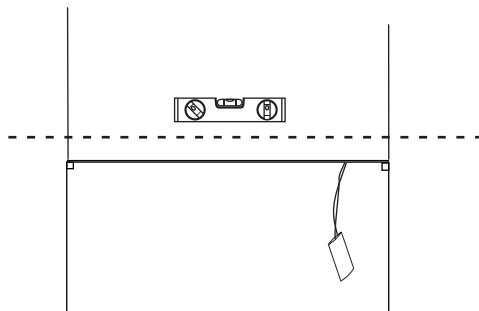

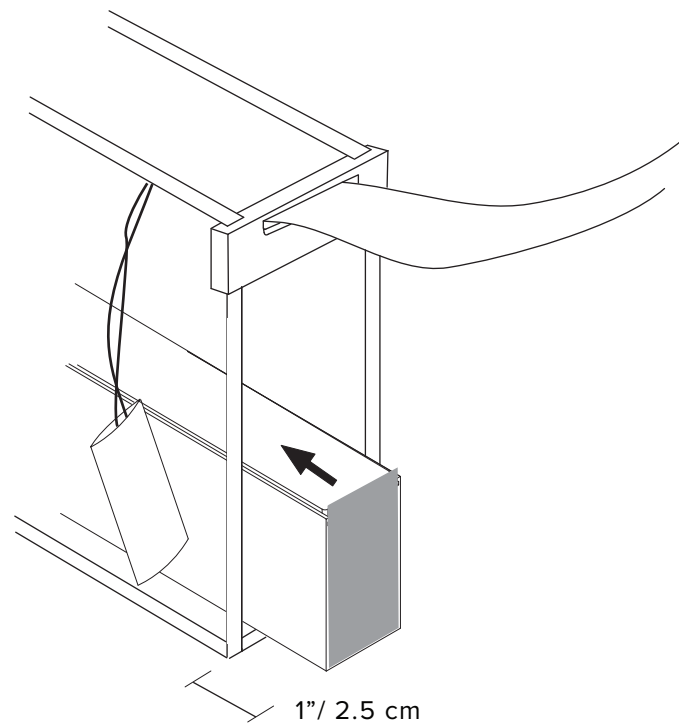
Ensure that the acrylic body is level and centered in between the positioning threads. If needed, adjust height. Then remove positioning threads from the ribbon.

Make sure to not scratch or damage your acrylic shade.



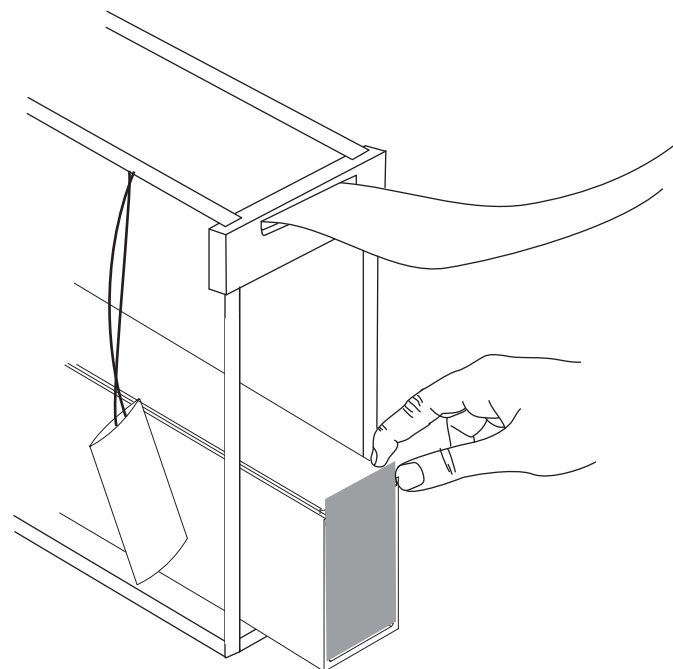

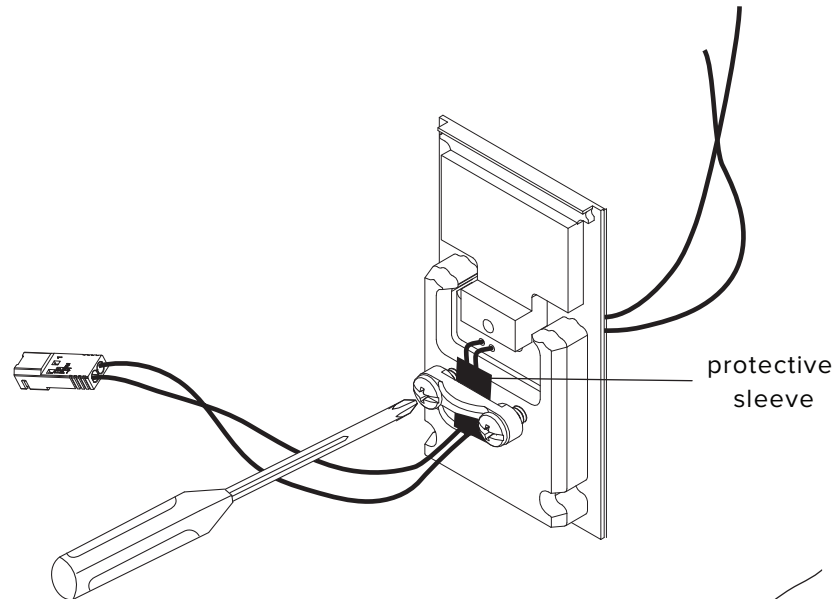


Make sure the wires do not stick out past the edge of the acrylic shade and that they sit properly.

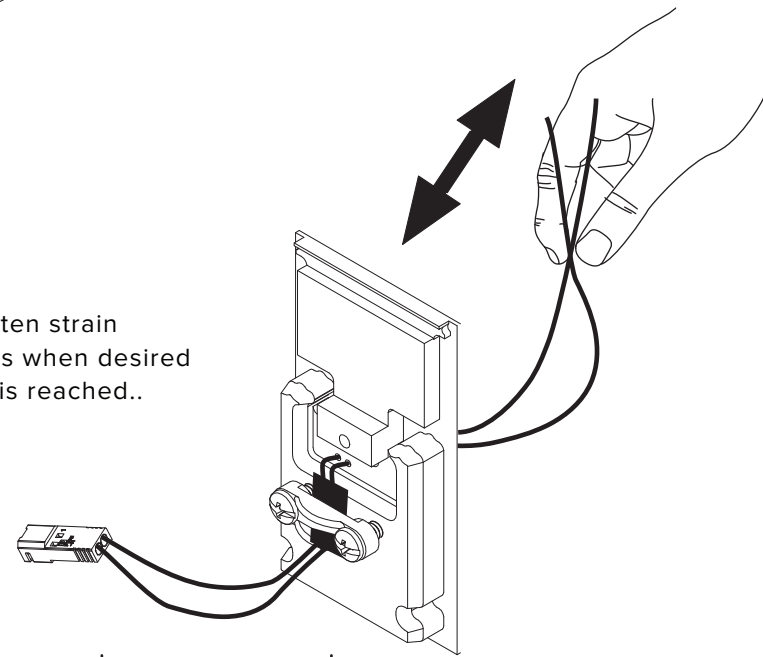


If your wires are too short or too long, unscrew end cap, loosen strain relief screws on, pull wires out further while making sure the protective sleeve stays under the strain relief.

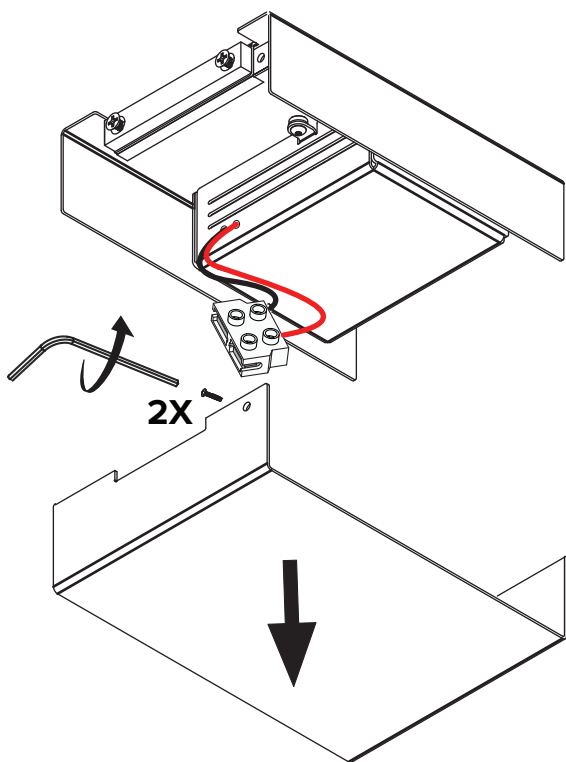

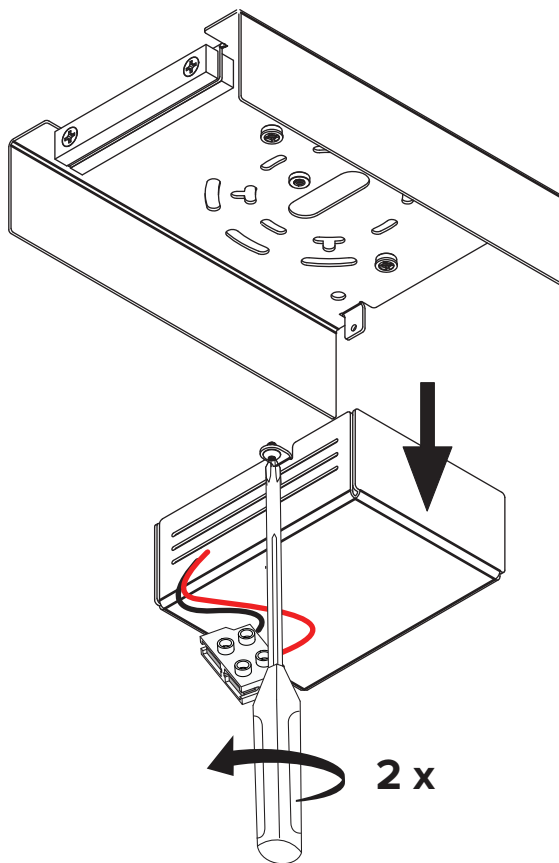

Remove the screws in the front and back of the canopy cover and lower it.

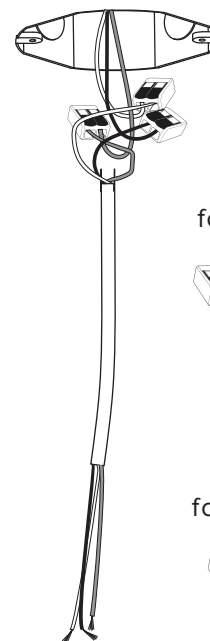

## MAKE LINE/MAIN VOLTAGE CONNECTION TO ELECTRICAL BOX (AC)

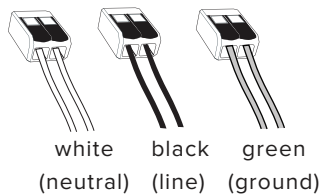

Connect the extension harness to AC input wires of the driver and connect ground from bracket to the harness.

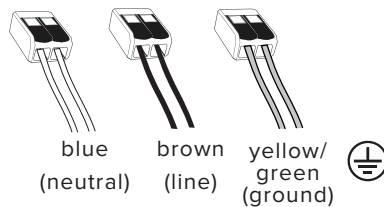


If applicable, use grey and purple wires for 0-10V dimming circuit, or the orange wires for DALI dimming circuit before closing the driver enclosure.

Carefully close driver enclosure. It is held by two screws.



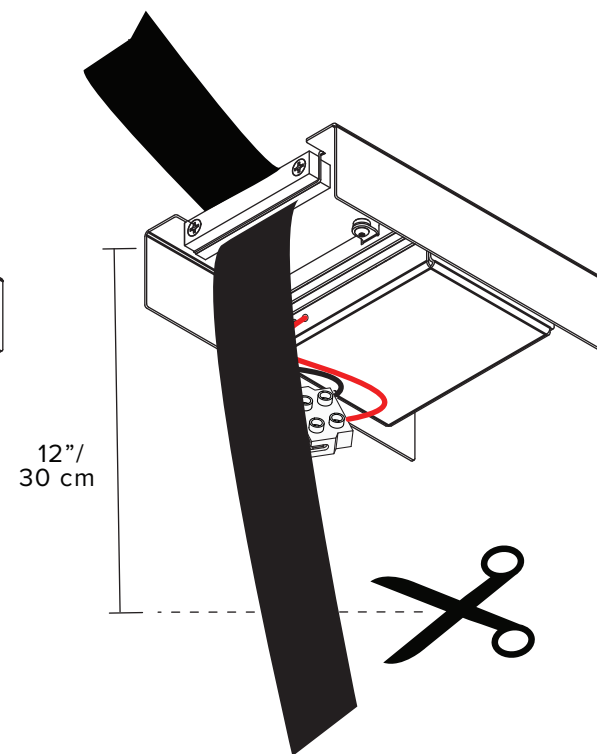

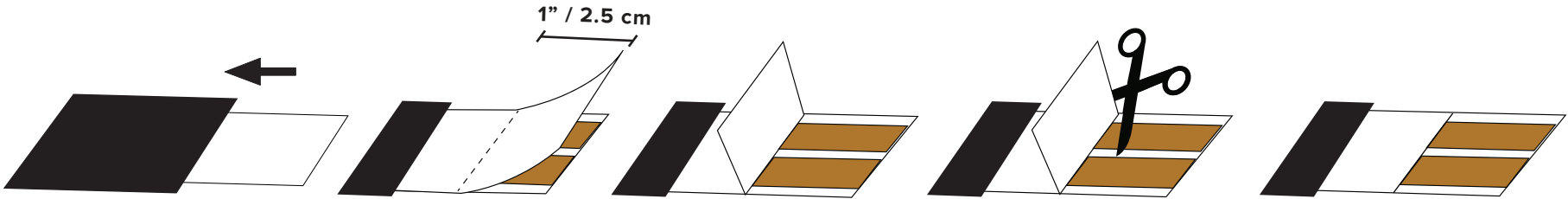

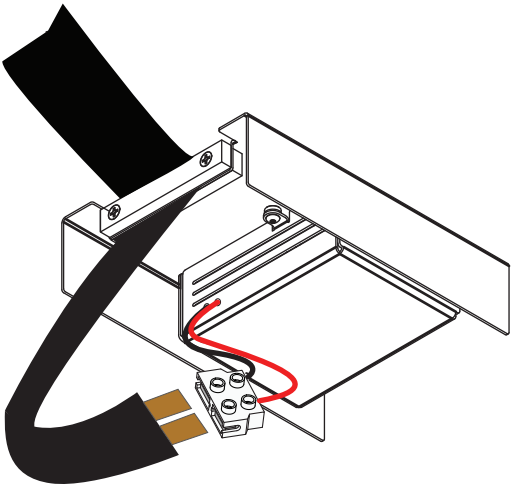
# UNSLEEVE CONDUCTORS

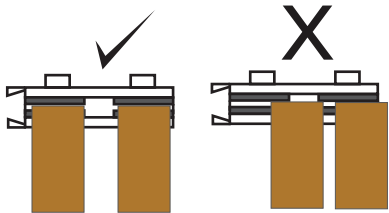


Push back the ribbon to reveal the copper conductor.

Peel off and fold 1" / 2.5 cm of the white, shiny covering and cut it off.

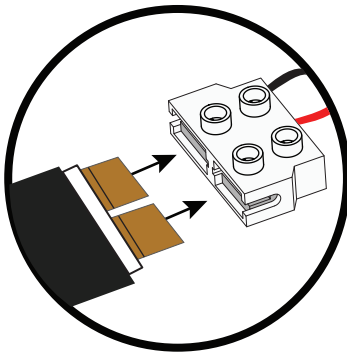


Both slots are the same and will receive either ribbon. (Polarity is not important)

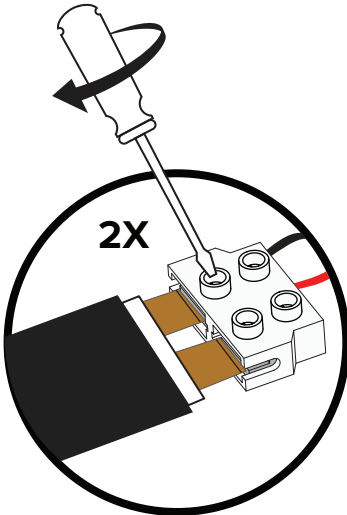


Do not overlap ribbons in both connectors

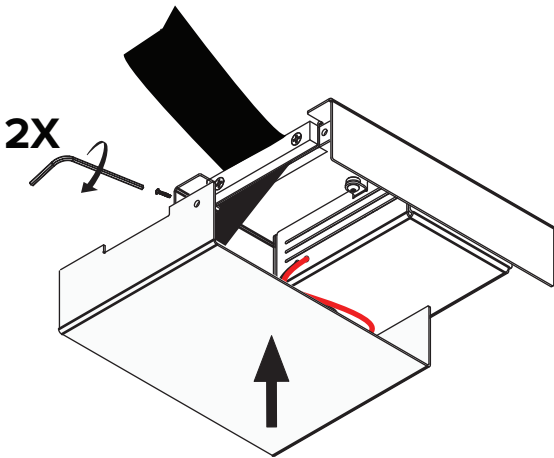

Carefully fold up extra ribbon within the housing.



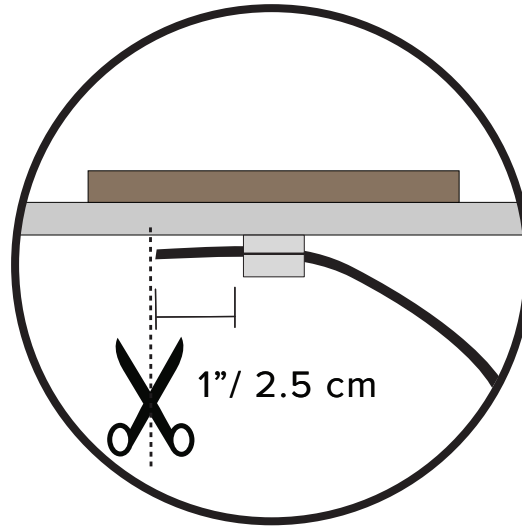
Note, one side of canopy cover is slotted for the ribbon



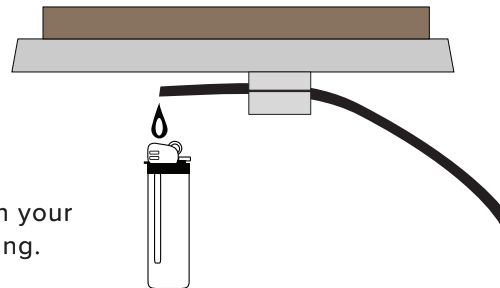
## FINAL VERIFICATION

When the luminaire is at the desired height and level, trim ribbon 1" / 2.5 cm after the anchor.

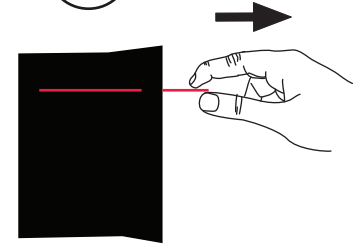


The extremity of the trimmed ribbon can be melted with the flame of a lighter for a few seconds to prevent fraying.



Be careful not to burn your fingers or the ceiling.

Pull out positioning thread

Use a feather duster or microfiber cloth to remove dust.

To clean finger prints, smudges or dirt on the acrylic, gently and very carefully clean the inside and outside of the shade using water and a microfiber cloth, then a dry microfiber cloth.

Do not use abrasive products or contaminated cloth as it could result in scratches on the surface!
