**Muuto’s first collaboration with Australian designer Rhys Cooper reimagines the classic Scandinavian wooden frame mirror**

Drawing on observations from his walks to work in Sydney and the arched windows of the architecture that surrounds him, Rhys Cooper started sketching the Arced Mirror.

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Arced Mirror is treated with an oil-based wood stain that brings forth the natural character and grain of the FSC™ (FSC-CO28824)-certified Spruce wood, available in three colors—Light Grey, Light Green and Light Lilac—three distinctly different expressions.

Initially compelled by handmade furniture, cabinetmaking and joinery, the Australia-based designer Rhys Cooper naturally progressed to focus on industrial design. While his work ranges from custom-made to industrially produced, the crafted feel and use of high-quality materials form an unmistakable tension.



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On the subject of the intersection of Scandinavian and Australian design, Cooper speaks of lessons learned and rightfully ignored — of finding your own way to relate to history.

“I see Scandinavian design as being relatively timeless. It has a level of craftsmanship and materiality — those are the qualities Arced Mirror is in dialogue with. The distinctiveness of the design is in the small details and that is often what characterizes Scandinavian design too. I’m not gonna say it is timeless yet,” laughs Rhys Cooper.

“Australian design is currently going through a big boom. The industry is growing. We are still defining our own aesthetic but have come a long way in a relatively short period of time. There are exciting things to come from Australian designers and I am excited to be a part of it.” says Rhys Cooper.

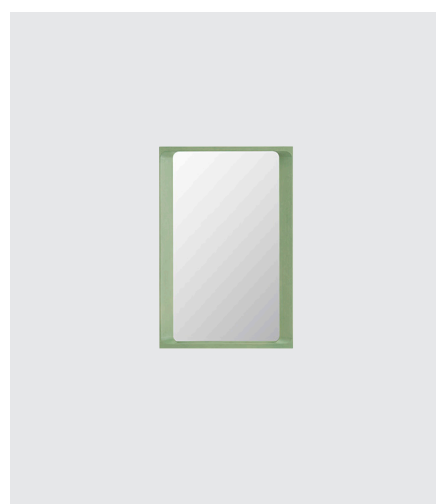
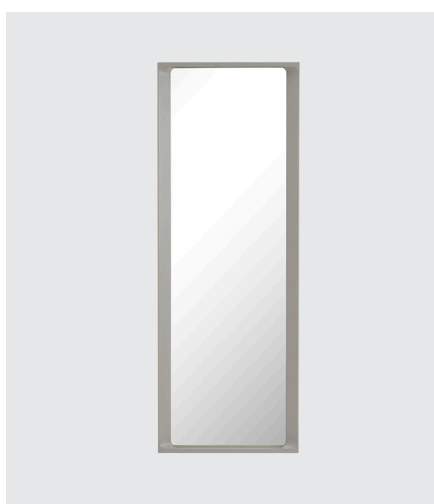
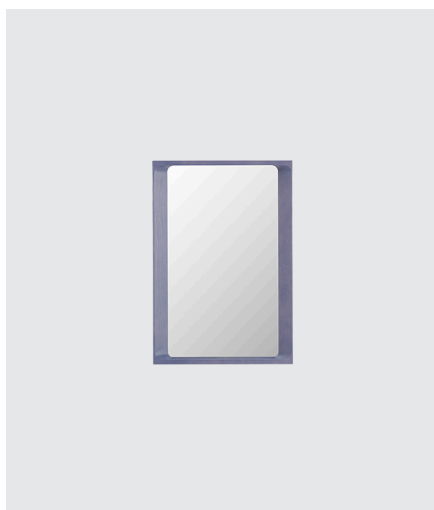
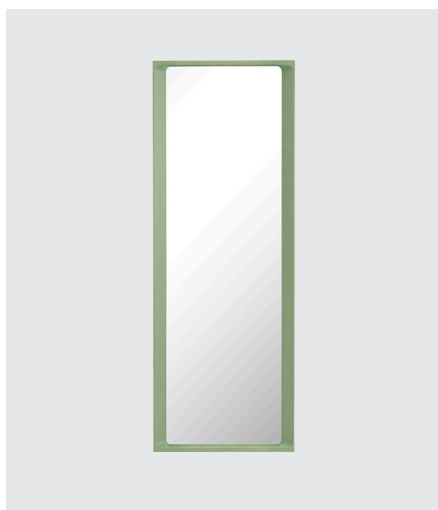
#### About Muuto
