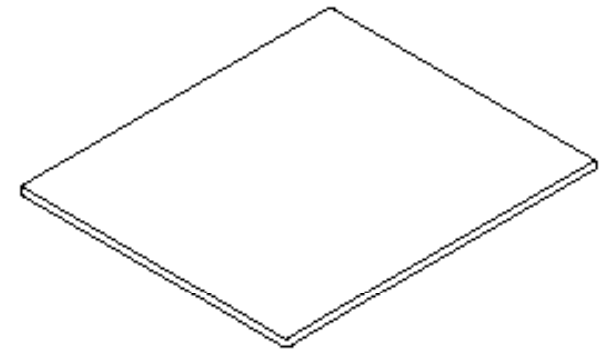

Made of recycled waste materials

Innovative technology allows us to make furniture of waste materials by combining a waste fibre with a waste binder material. The mix of materials results in a unique compound suitable for press moulding.

The Tabletop is made with a Matek™ blend of either coffee shell or wood waste mixed with post-consumer e-waste.

Take-back system

Our unique Matek™ material blends allow Mater to offer a circular take-back system. The take-back system is an essential step towards Mater's vision of becoming one hundred percent circular.

Maintenance guide

Please note that the tabletop is handcrafted and made from natural fibers, and plastic waste - minor blemishes and imperfections may be visible. These are not considered defects and do not interfere with the quality and function of the product.

Always remove stains quickly before they can do any permanent damage to the furniture. When you move your furniture, make sure you lift it rather than pulling or pushing it to avoid damaging the floor, legs and mountings. Avoid improper use such as tilting, putting your feet on the furniture or standing on it. Be careful not to damage or scratch the surface with sharp objects.

Matek™

For daily care, it is recommended to dust the surface with a soft cloth. The surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth wrung out in a mild solution of lukewarm water and a universal cleaning detergent. Avoid using abrasive cleaning agents and harsh detergents, as these may damage the surface.

Avoid placing Matek™ furniture in direct sunlight, excessive heat, or humidity over longer periods of time, as this can affect the appearance of the material. For tabletops, we always recommend using trivets under hot objects, such as coffee pots and cups, to prevent damage to the surface.

As Matek™ furniture is made from a blend of natural materials, each piece is unique, and its appearance may vary from item to item. A slight change in colour over the years is also to be expected.

Matek™ furniture also has a distinct smell when first unpacked, but this will fade after a few days of use.

Important Note

When assembling the Mater Tabletop to the Café, Bar, or Counter table base, always use a torque screwdriver to avoid damaging the mountings beneath the tabletop. Take care not to overtighten the screws.

When lifting or moving the table, always hold it by the base rather than the tabletop to prevent damage to the mountings.
