The panels are mounted onto a house façade, wooden fence, or other type of wall where it can stay all year round. The wall panels come in two different packaging's, either with one wall panel or two wall panels.

Care and maintenance

Our panels are hot dip galvanized, a surface treatment designed to give the panels the power to withstand moisture and the ability to self-heal from minor damages. Hot dip galvanizing also protects the panels from corrosion and requires no maintenance apart from regular cleaning. The method gives the surface a variation in colour, the grey tone of the panels might differ marginally due to this technique. With time any variation will even itself out. Wipe off any dirt with a damp cloth if necessary.
