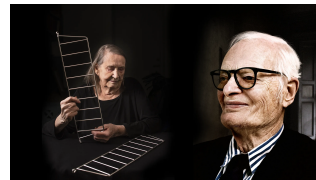

About the designer

Nisse Strinning, designer of the String® System, was a Swedish architect born in 1917 in the northern part of Sweden. Nisse designed the first String® shelf in 1949 with great help of his wife, Kajsa Strinning. The couple met while studying at KTH. Everything came about when the Swedish publishing house, Bonniers, announced a competition where they were looking for the perfect shelf. High in functionality, modern looking and with fair pricing. String® was selected winner and has been considered a classic Swedish design icon for decades.



Architect and designer Anna von Schewen is considered one of Swedens most progressive and experimental designers. She has together with her partner Björn Dahlström designed several products for String Furniture. Björn Dahlström is also a well-established Swedish industrial designer. He is represented in various museums around the world, including the national Museum for Art, Architecture and Design in Oslo, The Museum of Design & Craft (The Röhsska Museum) in Gothenburg and Victoria & Albert Museum in London.
