GENERAL PRODUCT INFORMATION:

These fixtures are intended to be installed utilizing NEC compliant junction boxes.

This product is suitable for damp locations.

This product can be dimmed with most ELV, TRIAC, or 0-10V dimmers.

This instruction shows a typical installation.

Prepare the Fixture



unscrewing/removing the Allen screws using the provided Allen wrench.

Secure the mounting plate to the electrical box with the two #8-32 screws provided.



Place the fixture on a level surface.

- With the provided Allen wrench, loosen (do not remove) the set screws on the strain reliefs.
- 5 Evenly pull the coaxial cables up through the strain reliefs to raise the fixture to the desired height. NOTE: Take caution to not remove the inner bushing from inside the strain relief while pulling the coaxial cord through.
- 6 Ensure that the canopy is level and re-tighten the set screws on the strain reliefs.

Shorten Cords (Optional)



3 Strip the end of the center conductor wire.

Wire the Fixture



- Connect the fixture ground wire to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 2 Connect the braided conductor wire to the black driver wire labeled "-" (negative) with a wire nut. NOTE: Ensure that the braided shield is being connected, not the center conductor wire.

Connect the center conductor wire to the red driver wire labeled "+" (positive) with a wire nut. NOTE: Ensure that the center conductor wire is being connected, not the braided coaxial shield.

Connect the black 120V input to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.

5 Connect the white 120V input to the neutral power line.

Install the Fixture



Place the canopy onto the mounting plate and secure it in place by screwing the reinstalling Allen screws using the provided Allen wrench.

Additional Leveling (optional)

NOTE: If necessary, minor leveling adjustments to the fixture may be needed. It is recommended that one person hold the fixture straight with the use of a level while the other adjusts the coaxial cable.

CAUTION: Only pull out extra cable for leveling if enough cord was left behind the canopy. Minimal amounts of cord should be pulled out for fine leveling.
