STEP 1



PLACE THE WOODEN DOWELS (A X 19) ONTO THE LEGS
AND THE CONNECTOR BY USING A SOFT Mallet.

PLEASE ASSEMBLE THE PRODUCT ON A SOFT CARPET OR RUG.





STEP 2

FIX THE BOLTS (B X 10) TO THE TABLE TOP BY HAND.





STEP 3

PUT THE BRASS DOWELS (H X 2) INTO THE HOLES
ON THE EDGES OF THE LEGS.





STEP 4

FIX THE BOLTS TO THE LEGS. THEN SLIDE THE CONNECTOR
ONTO THE LEGS, LETTING THE BOLTS PASS THROUGH. ATTACH
PART 'D' TO EACH BOLT AND TIGHTEN PART 'E' BY HAND.




STEP 5

PLACE THE FIXING HEADS INTO THE SLOTS ON THE LEGS. ATTACH THE LEGS TO THE CONNECTOR. THEN TIGHTEN THE HEX NUTS USING THE WRENCHES ON BOTH SIDES OF THE CONNECTOR.




STEP 6

PLACE THE FIXING HEADS INTO THE SLOTS ON THE LEGS
AND CONNECTOR. ATTACH THE LEGS AND THE CONNECTOR
TO THE TOP PANEL BY FIXING THE HEX NUTS.





STEP 7

INSERT 14 WOODEN PLUGS (J) AS SHOWN. A TOTAL OF 28 PLUGS ARE INCLUDED. THE REMAINING 14 PCS CAN BE KEPT FOR FUTURE MOVES OR IF THE TABLE NEEDS TO BE DISASSEMBLED.




STEP 8

REMOVE THE PROTECTIVE PAPER FROM THE FELT PADS AND
ATTACH THE PADS TO THE BOTTOM EDGE OF THE LEG PANELS.




STEP 9

TURN THE UNIT TO STANDING POSITION CAREFULLY.



STEP 10

NOW YOUR KIMONO DINING TABLE IS READY TO PUT INTO USE.
