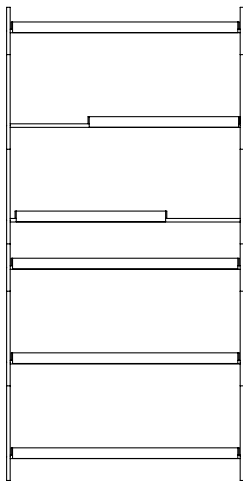


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

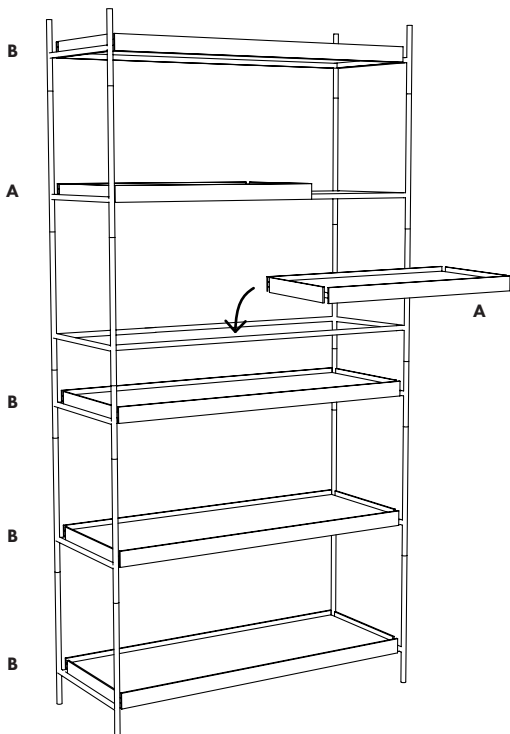
STEP 1

ASSEMBLE THE FRAME



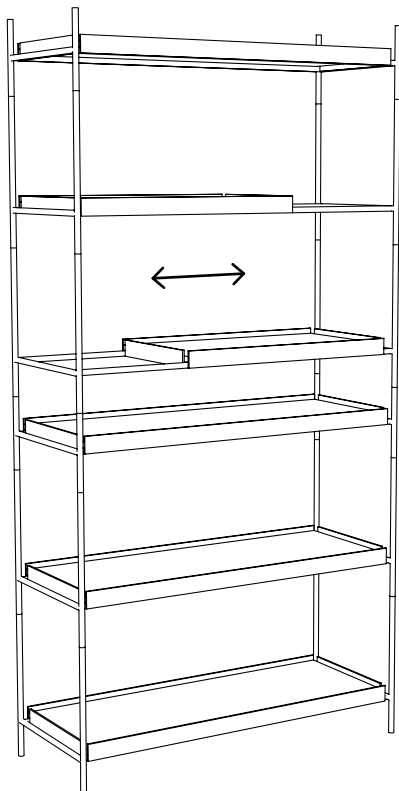
STEP 2

PLACE THE TRAYS IN THE FRAME



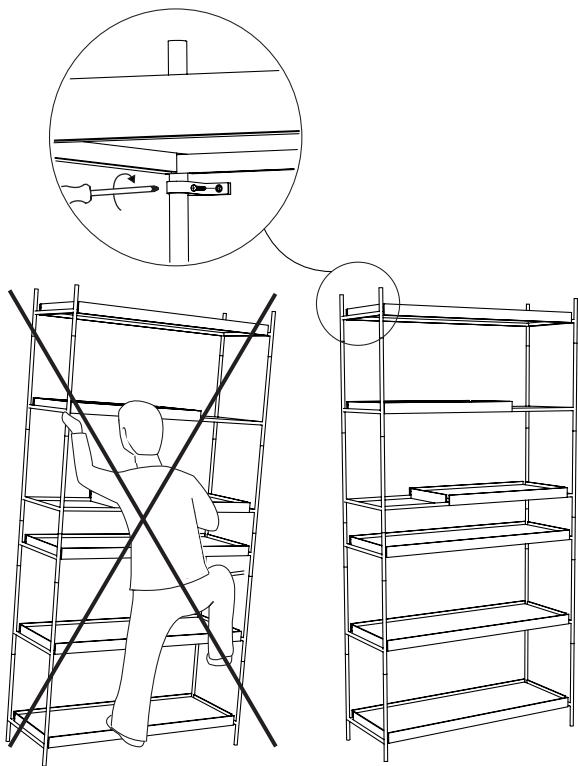
STEP 3
